To prepare, CDA launched **CA 2030** and is convening leaders in aging to identify opportunities for Area Agency on Aging (AAA) network-wide advancement and enhancement.

- Geography and demographics
- Governance
- Branding and communications
- Programs and services
- Performance measures

CA 2030's steering committee convenes monthly meetings and is in the process of developing a future-oriented framework with recommendations for both CDA and the California Aging Network.
