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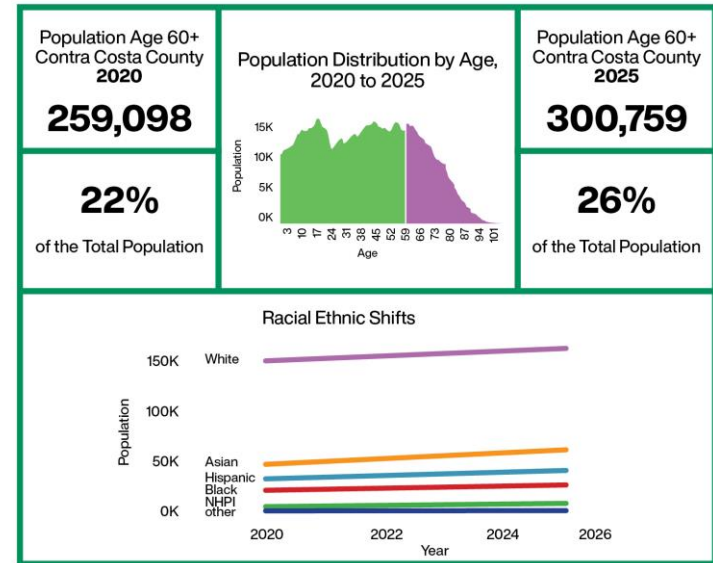
Contra Costa County Older Adults

In 2023, 58,826 (22%) of 60+ residents lived alone

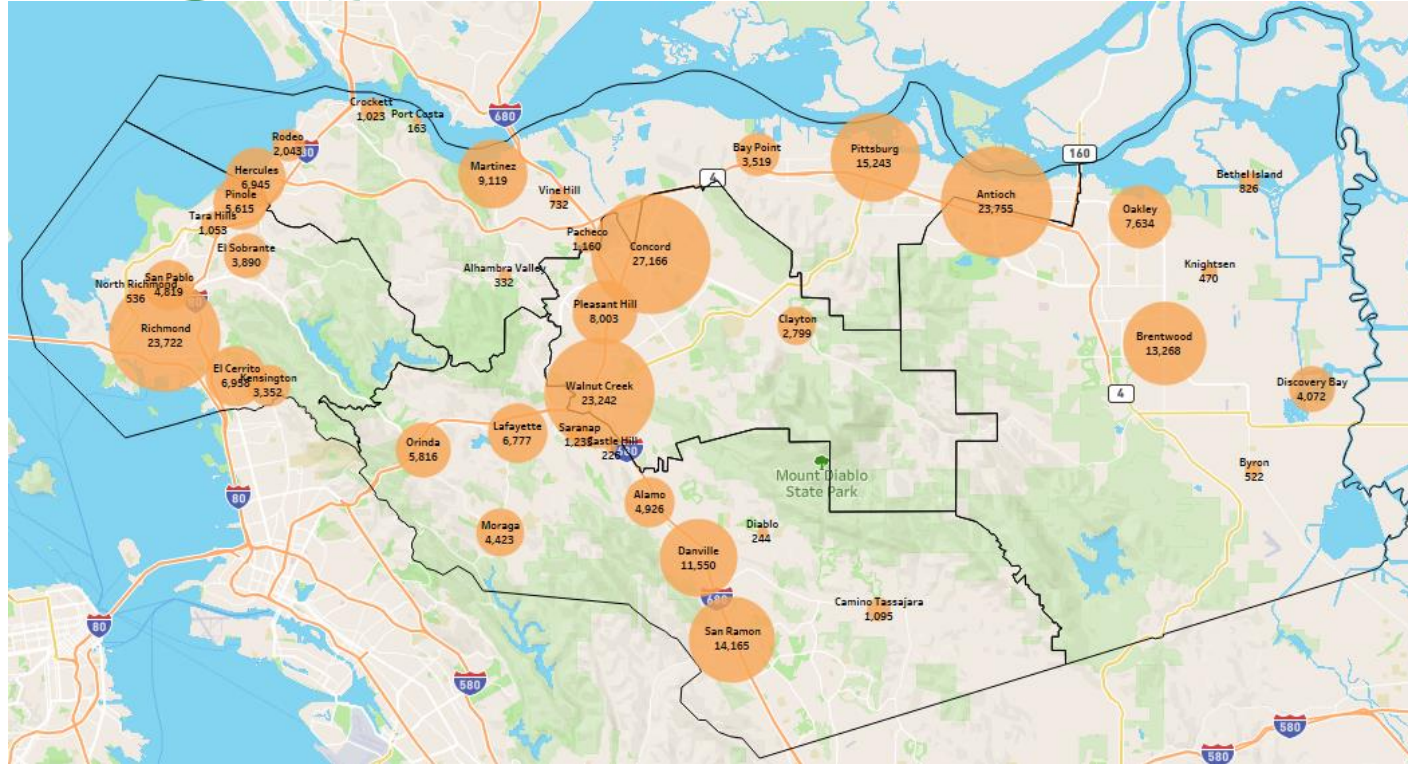
In 2023, 88,240 (33%) of 60+ are in the workforce

From 2020 to 2025, the number of 60+ residents increased by 41,661 (16%)



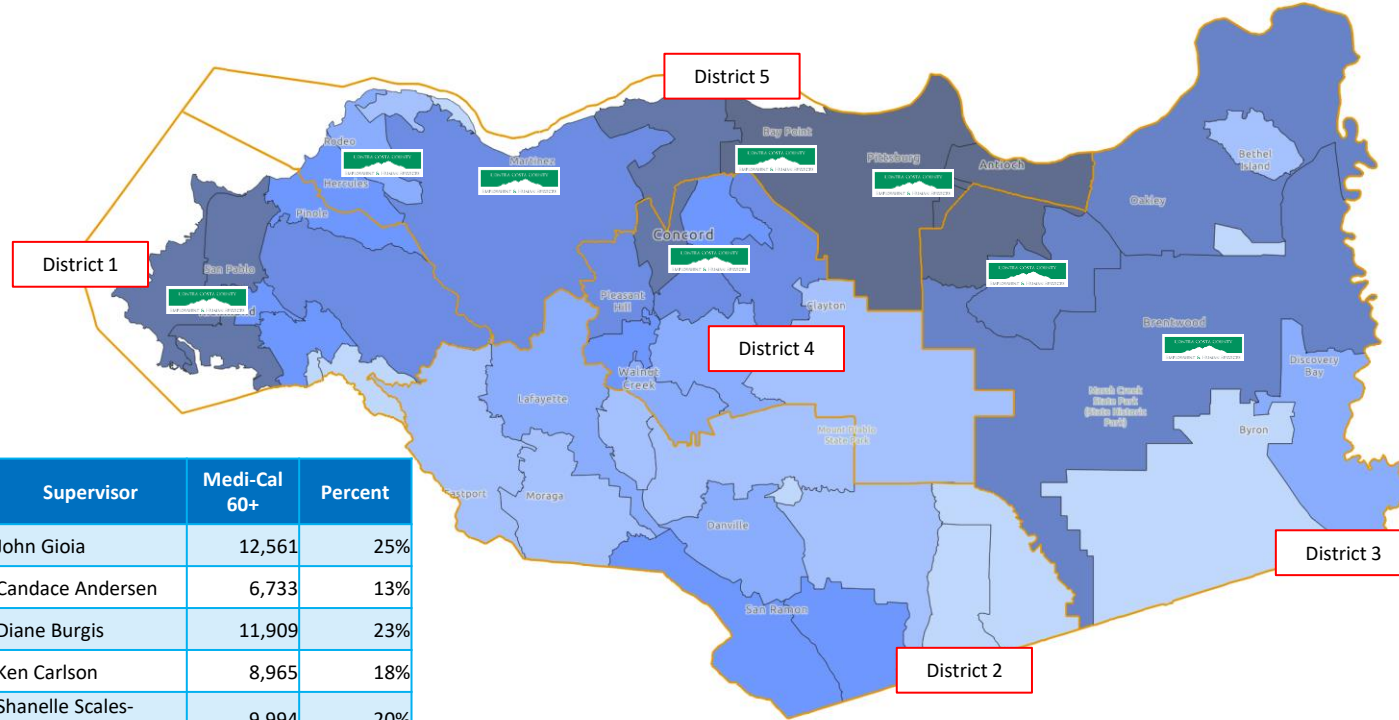
Geographic Distribution of 60+

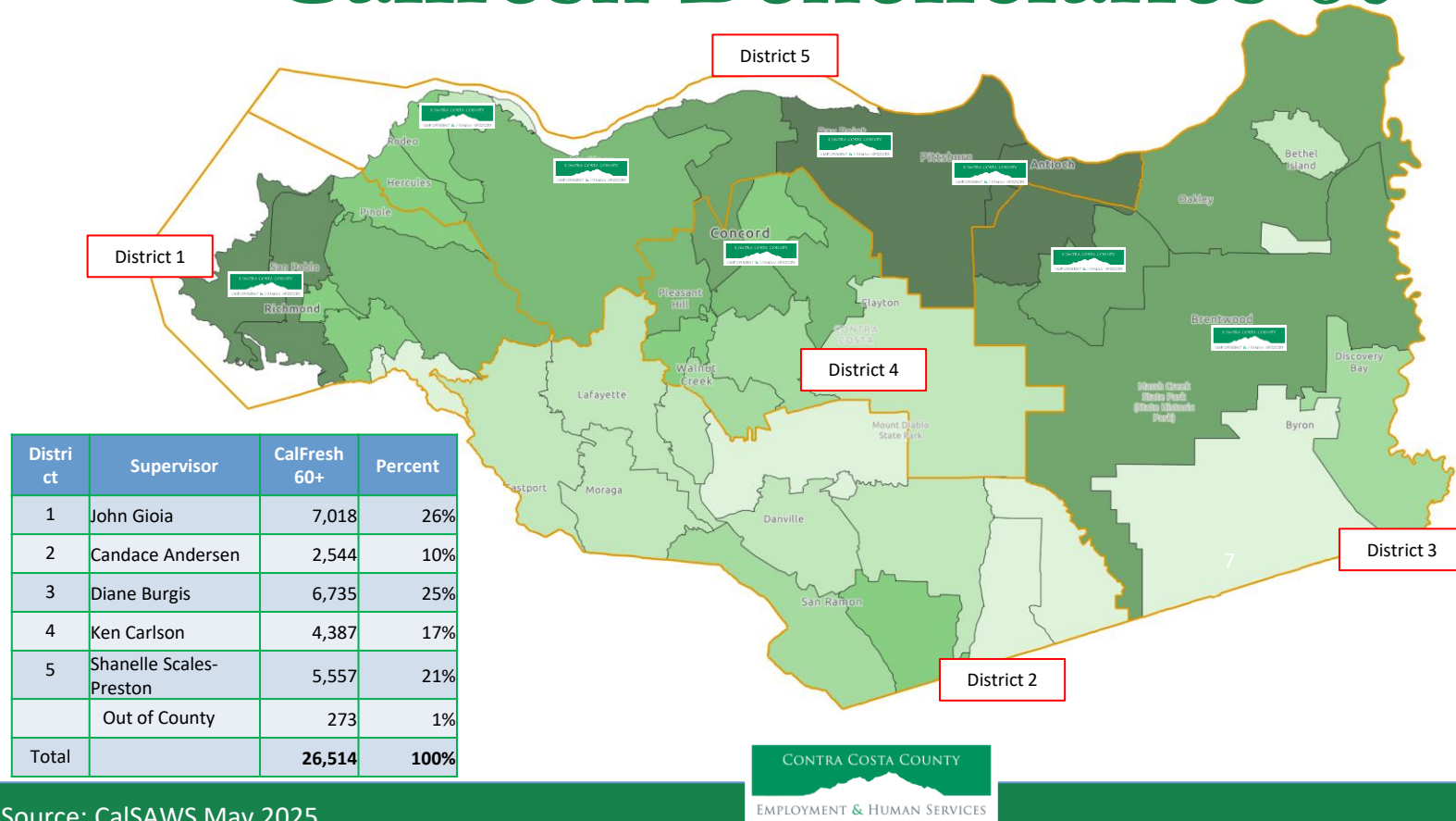

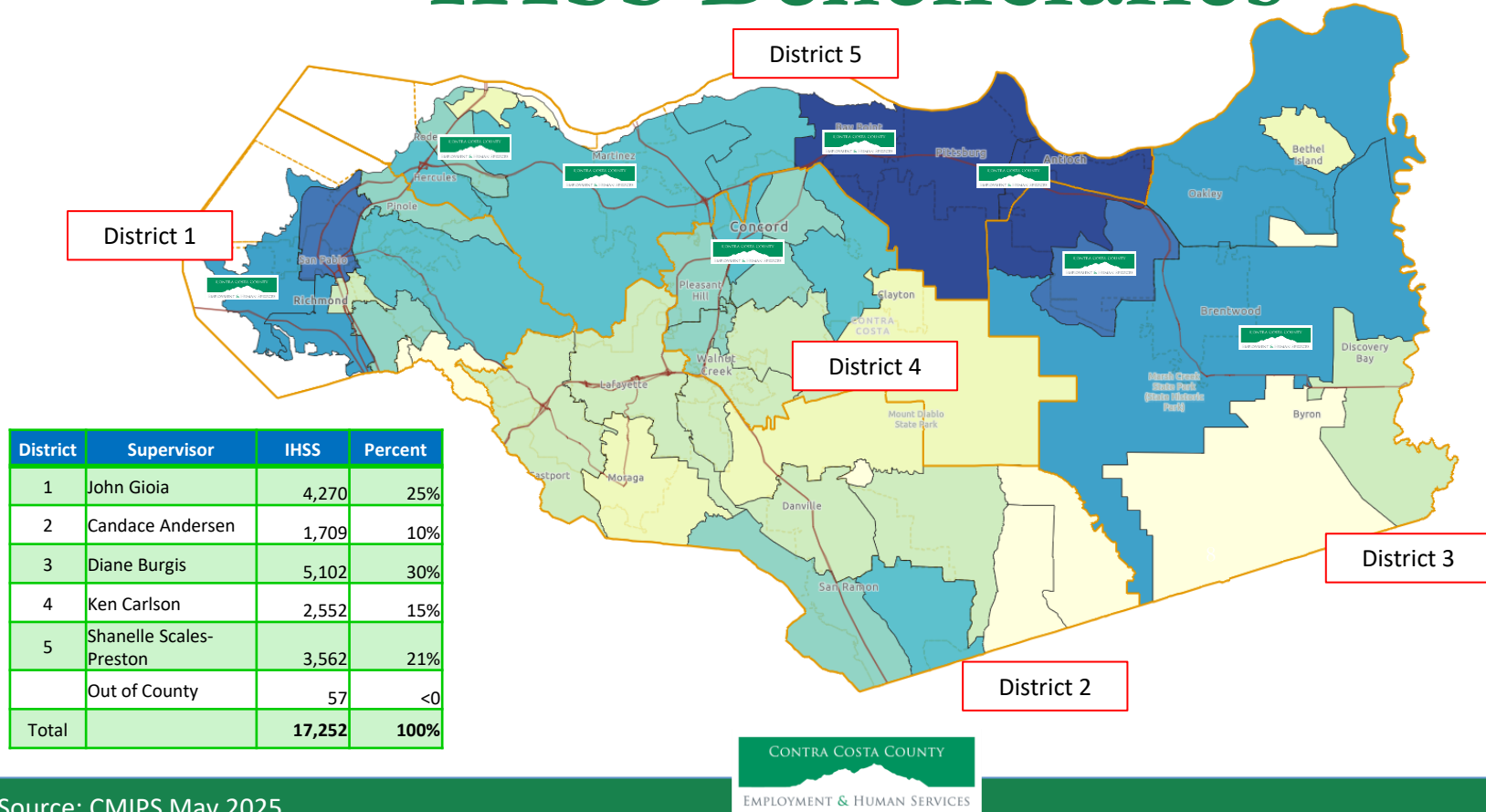

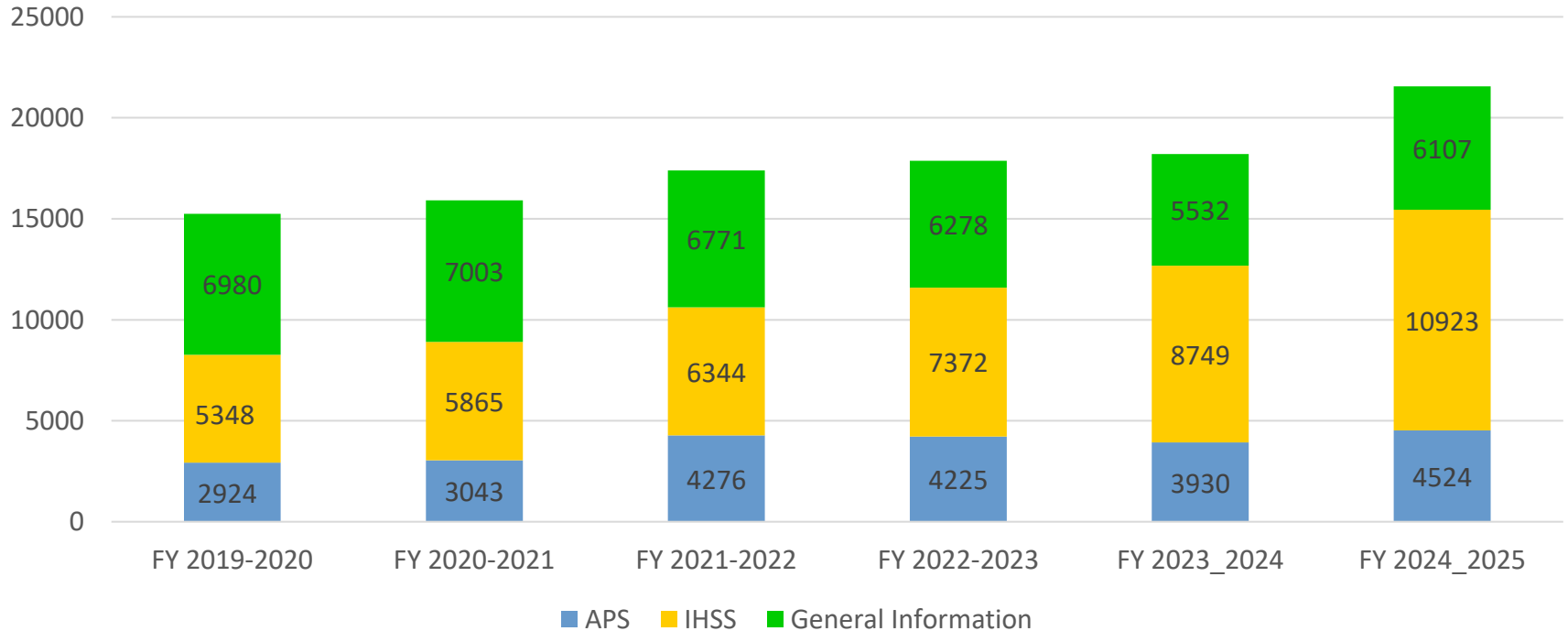

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State & Federal Budget Impacts

- Reinstatement of Medi-Cal Asset limits (\$130,000 individual + \$65,000 additional household member) may impact IHSS Consumers
- SNAP-Ed funding for education programs eliminated
- Cost sharing for overdue IHSS cases
