As Chair of the Economic Opportunity Council of Contra Costa County that prioritizes health care access to low-income residents, I urge the Board to take action toward ensuring equitable health care access by transitioning the Contra Costa CARES program eligibility requirements to align more closely with the County's Basic Health Care program and Medi-Cal. This step will close the gap by including the "remaining uninsured" newcomers who earn above 138% of FPL yet are ineligible for other healthcare coverage options.
