

Important Medi-Cal Changes For Some Adult Immigrants



Changes to Medi-Cal coverage are coming for many adult immigrants (age 19 and older).

Changes are coming to...



Enrollment

Starting January 1, 2026, undocumented adults will no longer be able to apply for full-scope Medi-Cal. Members already enrolled in full-scope Medi-Cal can keep their coverage as long as they renew. Children (under 19) and pregnant individuals who are undocumented will still have access to full-scope Medi-Cal.



Dental benefits

Starting July 1, 2026, Medi-Cal will stop covering non-emergency dental care for some adult members who are not U.S. citizens or Green Card holders.



Monthly premiums

Starting July 2027, some adults may need to pay a monthly fee for Medi-Cal.
