FIRST AMENDMENT TO LEASE

55 CASTLEWOOD DRIVE PITTSBURG, CA

This first amendment is dated September 19,2023 and is between the COUNTY OF CONTRA COSTA, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County") and YOUNG MEN'S CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION OF THE EAST BAY, a California nonprofit, public benefit corporation ("Lessee").

Recitals

- A. The County and Lessee are parties to a lease dated July 1, 2022, under which the Lessee is leasing from the County the property located at 55 Castlewood Drive, Pittsburg, California (the "Lease").
- B. County and Lessee are parties to a separate contract dated July 1, 2023, under which the Lessee is operating a Head Start program for the County at the Premises (such contract, as it may be amended from time to time, the "Service Contract"). Lessee desires to continue to lease the Premises for the purpose of satisfying its obligations under the Service Contract. The term of the Service Contract is through June 30, 2024.
- C. The parties desire to extend the term of the lease to correspond to the term of the Service Contract.

The parties therefore agree as follows:

Agreement

1. Section 2. Term is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

<u>Term.</u> The "**Term**" of this lease is two years, commencing on July 1, 2022, and continuing through June 30, 2024.

- a. If the Service Contract is renewed or extended, at the option of the County, the term of this lease may be extended by written amendment to this lease. In no event may the term of this lease be extended beyond the expiration or termination of the Service Contract. If the lease is extended in accordance with the terms of this lease, all references to the Term of this lease will be deemed to mean the Term as extended pursuant to this Section.
- b. If the Service Contract is terminated for any reason or for no reason, the Term of this lease will end on the same day that the Service Contract ends.
