The study has not begun yet. The County is currently finalizing an RFP for a study consultant for release.

The allocation request will fund the conduct of the San Pablo Avenue Enhanced Bicycle and Pedestrian Gap Closure Study. The study will identify and evaluate potential enhanced bicycle and pedestrian improvements along a segment of San Pablo Avenue from Richmond Parkway, through sections of Unincorporated County that includes Montalvin Manor, Tara Hills, and Bayview, through the City of Pinole, to the Pinole-Hercules border. The study scope will potentially include community and stakeholder engagement, analysis of existing conditions along the study corridor, development and evaluation of bicycle and pedestrian alternatives, and development of a final report.

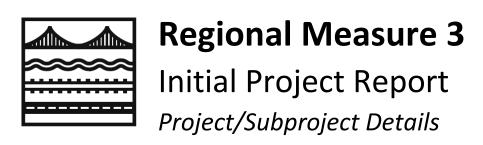

b. Detailed Project Description (include definition of deliverable segment if different from overall project/subproject)

The San Pablo Avenue Enhanced Bicycle & Pedestrian Gap Closure Study ("Study") will evaluate enhanced bicycle and pedestrian facilities, including low-stress bicycle facilities, sidewalk and intersection improvements, active transportation safety enhancements, and enhanced connections to local public transit, on San Pablo Avenue between Richmond Parkway and the Pinole/Hercules border ("Study Corridor"). The final deliverable will be a Study that identifies strategies and recommendations to improve multimodal connectivity and safety along the Study Corridor and close an existing San Francisco Bay Trail gap.

c. Impediments to Project Completion

Contra Costa County does not foresee any impediments to conducting the Study. Contra Costa County and the City of Pinole will execute a cooperative agreement to ensure both parties collaborate to provide a local cash match and complete the Study. The Study sponsors will continually monitor the



Study consultant's work to ensure that the consultant is meeting the Study scope, schedule, and budget. Regular meetings will be held with stakeholders and the public to ensure that their input is incorporated into the study to minimize the need to schedule additional meetings or devote additional time to address any specific issues that may arise during the conduct of the Study.

Future projects that would be identified in the Study will be subject to a more detailed review of right-of-way, utility conflicts, and engineering standards. These factors could impact the construction of these projects. The Study will help identify potential impediments during the project scoping phase to minimize future delays to construction.

d. Risk Management (describe risk management process for project budget and schedule, levels of contingency and how they were determined, and risk assessment tools used)

Contra Costa County will set aside up to 10% of the total Study budget for contingency, consistent with standard Contra Costa County practice. Once a deadline to complete the Study is finalized between Contra Costa County and MTC, Contra Costa County will develop a Study schedule that concludes 3-6 months before the deadline to accommodate any possible delays that may occur during the Study's development. Contra Costa County's contract with the Study consultant will include language to execute an action plan to address any delays during the Study's development and keep it on schedule.

For construction projects, Contra Costa County uses project scheduling tools such as Microsoft Project to track critical deadlines and keep projects on schedule and in budget. More complex projects with potential risks have a more flexible timeline to account for possible delays. Contingency is usually set to 10% unless the project has identified risks that require further analysis as design progresses.

Contra Costa County and the City of Pinole will be responsible for operating and maintaining bicycle and pedestrian improvements that result from the study's recommendations within their respective jurisdiction.

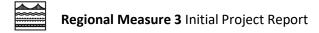
