ORDINANCE NO. 2023-16

AN ORDINANCE DELEGATING TO THE WORK FURLOUGH ADMINISTRATOR THE AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER COUNTIES TO TRANSFER PRISONERS PURSUANT TO PENAL CODE 1208.5

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows:

Section 1. Purpose.

- A. California Penal Code Section 1208.5 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to enter into agreements to transfer prisoners assigned to a work furlough program to and from Contra Costa County and other counties that maintain work furlough programs.
- B. The Board of Supervisors may, by ordinance, delegate the authority to enter into these agreements to the Work Furlough Administrator.
- C. The Sheriff is the County's Work Furlough Administrator.

Section 2. Delegation of Authority.

The Board of Supervisors delegates to the Work Furlough Administrator the authority to enter into agreements to transfer prisoners assigned to a work furlough program to and from Contra Costa County and other counties that maintain work furlough programs.

Section 3. Severability.

If any provision of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is the intent of the Board of Supervisors that such invalid provision(s) be severed from the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance becomes effective 30 days after passage, and within 15 days after passage shall be published once with the names of supervisors voting for or against it in the East Bay Times, a newspaper published in this County.
