Minutes of Meeting on September 16, 2025

<u>Committee Members in Attendance:</u> Jason Hill, Lee Mlejnek, Rich Johnson, Mark Young, Mark Cordone, Corey Berla

Committee Members Absent: Jason Dudum, Bernard Corey

<u>Guests in Attendance:</u> Deputy Shanks, Cameron Collins (Field Representative for the Supervisor's Office), Elaine Schroth (Round Hill North Resident), Ivan and Jacqueline Lee (Round Hill Residents)

The P-5 Advisory Committee was held at Alamo Plaza, Suite 170A. Jason Hill called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM.

Public Comment: Elaine Schroth had questions and concerns about an early morning police raid on a home on Rolling Hills Court. This home has been a trouble spot in the neighborhood with many late night visitors and other disruptive behaviors. Ivan Lee also discussed this home and asked the Committee how communication of this kind of event is disseminated and inquired if there are additional steps residents can take to be notified and protect themselves. Deputy Shanks gave a detailed accounting of the action on Rolling Hills Court and how law enforcement is required to deal with the event itself and any results such as arrest, eviction or judicial requirements. He also reminded the Committee and Guests that civil actions may limit law enforcement. Mark Young advised that everyone can be proactive by using 911 to report suspicious activity to get law enforcement notified and involved and this was the best way for Residents to be proactive in protecting the Round Hill area.

<u>Financial Report:</u> Mark Young commented that the financial situation is status quo and in line with his recent estimates. Discussion centered on the combination of the Alamo Police Districts and how that would affect financial reserves and the ability to fund other actions to promote safety and security in Alamo all to the benefit of residents.

P-5 Activity Report: Deputy Shanks reported that there were no significant incidents last month in the P-5 Area. The HOA purchased speed trailer continues to provide statistics on the speeds and hourly timing of those speeds and indicates a majority of the traffic is obeying speed limits. If the Committee believes there are any areas of concern please let the Deputies know. As the trailer is moved around to different areas in Round Hill over the coming months there will be a much more complete picture of where and to what extent vehicles exceeding the speed limit are occurring.

There were 2 recorded vehicle stops and warnings for stop sign violations and speeds over the 25 mph limit during August with 1 citation issued. There were 34 hours of overtime and no out of area assistance noted for August.

Old Business: Discussion continued about the issue of forming a single Alamo Police District.

New Business: none

<u>Approval Of Minutes:</u> Minutes for June and July were approved with one correction to reflect that Corey Berla is a member of the P-5 Advisory Committee.

Meeting adjourned at 8:20 PM.


