1. Call to Order/Roll Call/Pledge of Allegiance

- **2.** Approval of Agenda Motion to approve the agenda by Member Lessley, second by Member Torres, motion carried 6/0/1
- **3.** Approval of Minutes Motion to approve minutes by Member Lessley, second by Member Shah, motion carried 6/0/1
- **4. Public Comment** There was a comment made regarding lack of activities for youth in Bay Point. Another comment was made regarding speeding on local streets and should re refer to CHP.

5. Agency Reports

- **a.** Contra Costa Sheriff's Office Lt. Daniels The Lt. shared there had been a recent Basketball camp for local youth and the Bike Rodeo is on May 17th, he invited any vendors in the community who would like to set up a table or booth to come. Crime trends remain about the same.
- **b.** Contra Costa Code Enforcement Joe Losado Joe noted that in March we had 35 cases opened, 32 cases closed and 55 current, this month we have 92 cases opened/53 cases closed and 97 current. The higher numbers reflect the new staff he has been able to

bring on. They are going to concentrate on cars parked in Shore Acres that are inoperable. He also reported that there is a house on Peninsula waiting to be abated.

- **c.** Contra Costa Fire Michelle Rinehart Michelle reminded us it is weed abatement time, so make sure you cut your weeds. She also told us the local maps will be up for review starting on May 20, 2025
- **d.** Golden State Water Tina Gonzalez Tina reported that they are taking care of weed abatement and have projects starting the Willow Pass Extension. Alves, Pullman and Fairview will all have work being done. Member of the public asked about noise at the Pacifica/Wharf intersection pumping station.
- e. MOTCO Chief Armacost The Chief gave us an update on Coyote Shield, the practice evacuation that will take place on June 19th. He also shared that a couple of servicemen put out a fire the observed down by the waterfront.
- 6. Items for Discussion
 - **a.** Armando Carrasco Bay Point Cleanup Event Update Armando shared a slide show of the clean up day, we were able to get a lot of areas cleaned-up. He shared that there will be a Community Goal Setting Meeting in the Riverview MU on May 12, 2025 from 6-7:30 to identify projects that improve the community. There will be a grant writing seminar at the Ambrose Center.
 - **b.** Jamar Stamps, DCD Principal Planner County Tree Ordinance Update Jamar shared that you need to check with the County before removing trees, you may need a permit to remove it.
 - c. Thanh Vo, Senior Engineer and Max David, Junior Engineer- Update on Delta Diablo's Bay Point Collection Point Repairs Project Thanh Vo shared the information with the community regarding the number to call if there is a blockage and they will determine if they need to fix it or the homeowner. Max David shared that there will be work being done on the following streets, Water, Franklin, Bella Vista, Ambrose, Cleveland, Willow Pass, North Broadway and Nichols.
