Suicide-related

- Caller has thoughts of suicide.
- OR: Caller is concerned about someone else.

Crisis / Grief

- In crisis, but not related to suicide.
- In crisis or stressed or grieving.
- OR: Caller is concerned about someone else.

Public Safety Power Shutoff: call 211

- In order to keep communities safe, PG&E may need to turn off power when extreme weather or wildfire conditions are forecast. This statewide initiative is called Public Safety Power Shutoff.
- Learn how to prepare for a PSPS event and sign up for notifications
- Provide additional help for those with access and functional needs (AFN)

Contra Costa Services Network (CCSN)

- New Pilot Project thanks to funding from John Muir Health Foundation & Lesher Foundation, 1st year is free
- Pilot project offers a coordinated information exchange via a case management CRM with access to 211CC internal database
- Accommodates multiple programs in a single system with a built-in referral system as well as follow-up system
- Different Reportable tools for easy reporting access including data aggregation amongst providers
- Close-loop referrals and bi-directional electronic referrals to save providers time
- No need for clients to retell their demographics and traumatic stories to providers

- Mobile grief response for schools, agencies, and businesses.

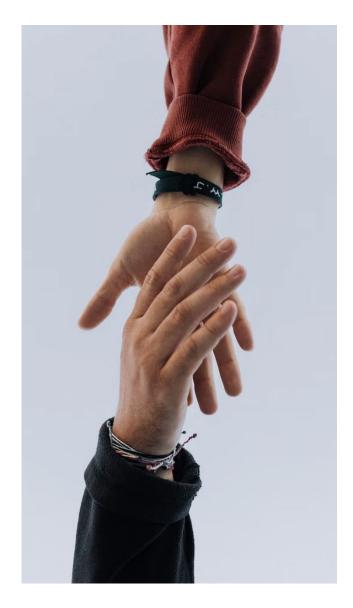

- Survivors After Suicide Loss
- Parent Loss of A Child
- Spouse / Partner Loss
- Friends / Family Loss
- Children / Youth who are grieving a death (ages 6+).





PES Suicide Prevention Follow Up Program

- County Psychiatric Emergency Services (PES) in Martinez is offering our services to clients discharging from their psych emergency room
- Offered to patients whose reason for admission into PES was Suicidal Ideation
- Opt in by designated Text or Faxed Referral
- •Immediate 24/7 support from crisis counselors
- Safety plan, coping strategies, resource linkages
- Designed to prevent suicide deaths, reduce reattempts and subsequent re-hospitalizations
- •Increases linkages to community-based services for ongoing treatment/support
