ORDINANCE OF THE CONTRA COSTA COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AND THE CROCKETT-CARQUINEZ FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TO DESIGNATE FIRE HAZARD SEVERITY ZONES

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors, as and constituting the Board of Directors of the Contra Costa County Fire Protection District and the Crockett-Carquinez Fire Protection District, ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. SUMMARY

This ordinance is adopted to designate fire hazard severity zones within the jurisdictions of the Contra Costa County Fire Protection District and the Crockett-Carquinez Fire Protection District, pursuant to Section 51179 of the Government Code.

SECTION 2. DESIGNATION OF FIRE HAZARD SEVERITY ZONES.

The Contra Costa County Fire Protection District and the Crockett-Carquinez Fire Protection District hereby designate the fire hazard severity zones depicted on the map attached hereto as **Exhibit A**, as recommended by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection, Office of the State Fire Marshal, pursuant to Section 51178 of the Government Code. The map attached as **Exhibit A** is hereby approved and incorporated by reference into this ordinance. An electronic version of the map depicting the designated fire hazard severity zones shall be maintained on and accessible from the Contra Costa County Fire Protection District official website.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
