

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-10
(Exclude from the Merit System the new Deputy Director of Risk Management-Exempt, and non-substantive Section formatting & Heading Update)

The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors ordains as follows (omitting the parenthetical footnotes from the official text of the enacted or amended provisions of the County Ordinance Code):

SECTION I: Section 33-5.377 of the County Ordinance Code is amended to exclude from the merit system the new classification of Deputy Director of Risk Management-Exempt and make non-substantive section formatting and heading update as follows:

33-5.377 – Risk management.

- (a) The director of risk management-exempt is excluded and is appointed by the county administrator.
- (b) The deputy director of risk management-exempt is excluded and is appointed by the director of risk management-exempt.
