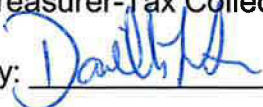

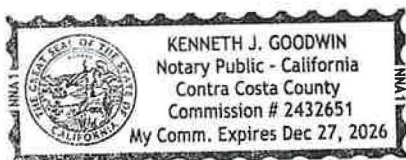

ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS: Section 12. Power of Attorney.
