

TRANSCRIPT FOR THE TEFRA HEARING


February 13, 2024 10:00 a.m.

This noticed public hearing is required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Code”). The hearing is with regard to the proposed issuance of tax-exempt revenue bonds (“bonds”) by the California Municipal Finance Authority (CMFA) in an amount not to exceed four hundred million dollars (\$400,000,000). A portion of the proceeds from the sale of the bonds, in an amount not to exceed fifty-five million (\$55,000,000) will be used to finance and/or refinance certain capital projects at the Keller Canyon Landfill located at 901 Bailey Road, Pittsburg, CA 94565.

TEFRA requires that a public hearing be held by a governing body of the jurisdiction in which a project to be financed is located, and that the governing body approve the proposed financing solely for the purposes of satisfying the requirements of TEFRA, the Code, and the California Government Code Section 6500. The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors may consider adoption of a resolution approving the issuance of the bonds on February 27, 2024. Any comments provided at this hearing will be made available to the Board of Supervisors prior to their taking action on February 27 or on such later date as the matter may be considered by the Board of Supervisors.

If there are parties present who wish to voice their opinion and provide comments on the proposed financing of the development or the issuance of the bonds, I would ask that they be recognized now by raising their hand. I will then let each person provide any written or oral testimony that they may wish to provide on this matter.
