Microenterprise Home Kitchen Operation (MEHKO)



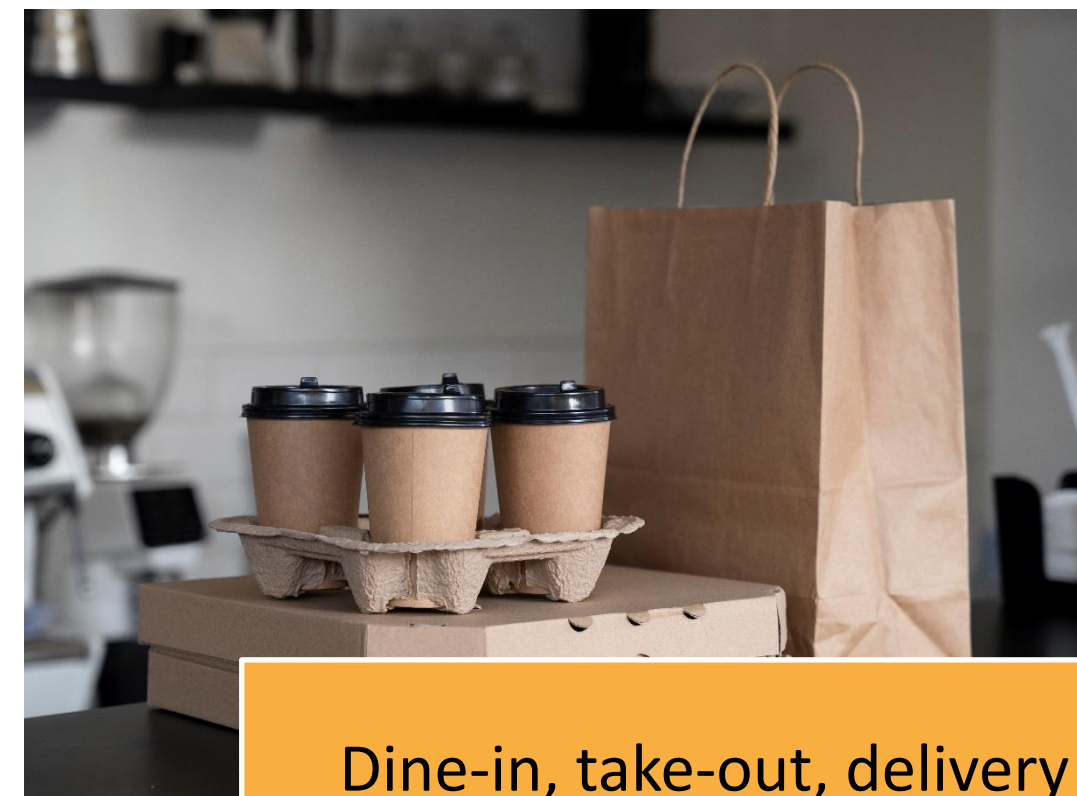
Small-scale restaurant operated by a resident in a private home



Limited to 30 meals per day and 90 meals per week

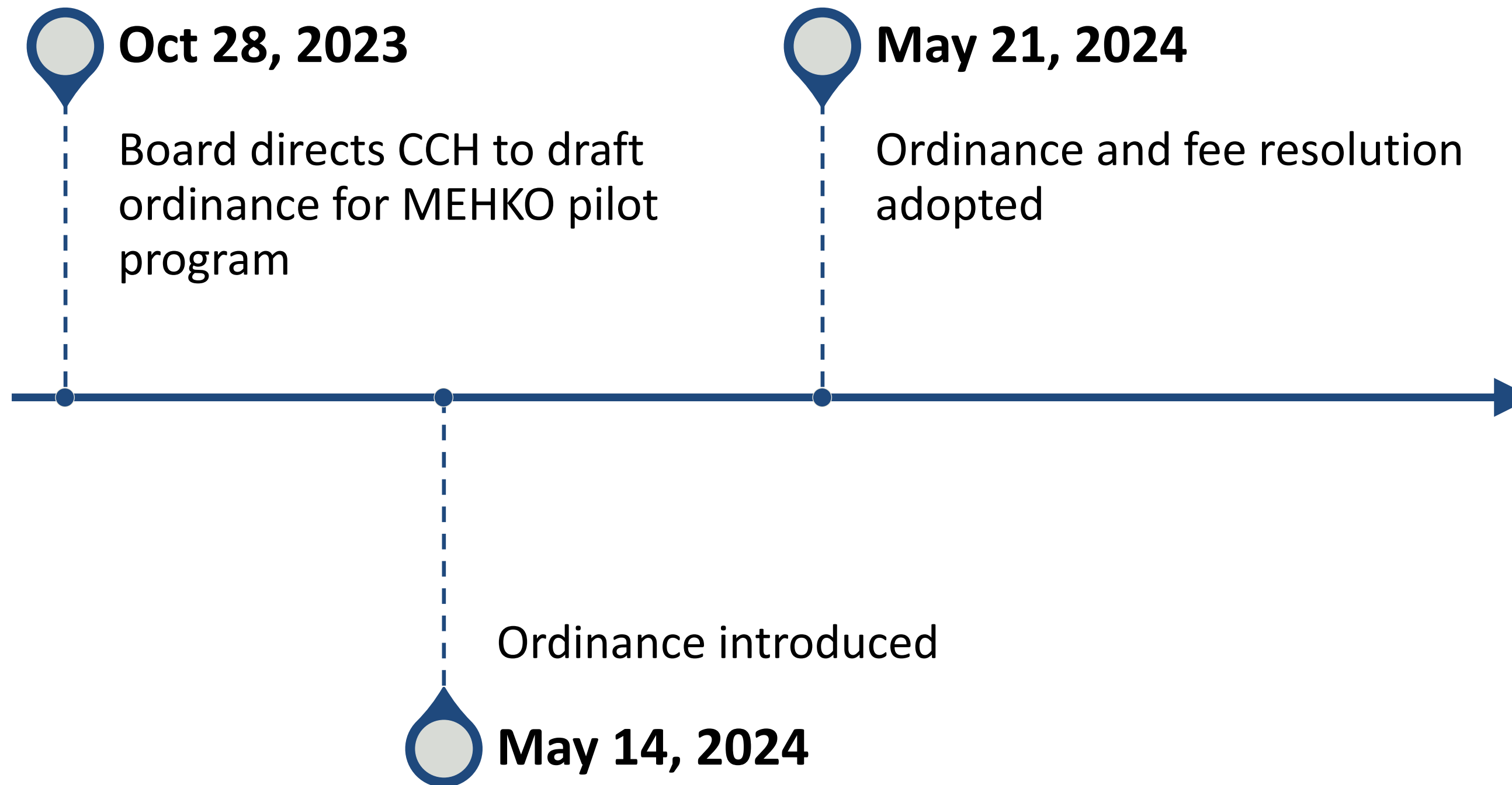


Up to \$100,000 gross annual sales



Dine-in, take-out, delivery

MEHKO Program Timeline



Proposed Ordinance

- Authorizes and regulates MEHKOs throughout Contra Costa County
- Requires MEHKOs to obtain a valid permit from Contra Costa Health
- Specifies permitting and operational requirements
- Expires June 30, 2026 unless repealed or extended by the Board

Initial Permit	\$696
Renewal Permit	\$345
Review of Updated Standard Operating Procedures	Hourly Rate
