Those participating in person should speak when called upon by the chair. Those participating via Zoom should indicate they wish to speak by using the “raise your hand” feature in the Zoom app. Those calling in should indicate they wish to speak by pushing * 9 on their phone. All public comments will be limited to 2 minutes per speaker.
