
Contra Costa County (the “County”) was pleased to have another opportunity to meet with yourself and elected leadership during the Brentwood City Council Meeting on January 27, 2026 to provide an update on the progress of the East County Service Center Project on Technology Way. It is my understanding from County staff at the meeting that several members of City Council and members of the public expressed a desire for the County to host a community forum about the project. While we had not received a formal written request on this matter until today, this letter was drafted last week to inform you that after careful consideration, the County will not be holding a community forum on this project.

The County has had numerous publicly noticed meetings wherein this project was discussed and community input was solicited going back to January 18, 2011 when the County purchased the land at Technology Way for this purpose. This was again reaffirmed in the Capital Facilities Master Plan, which the Board adopted in 2022 in a September Board of Supervisors meeting. In addition, the East County Service Center Project has been highlighted in the Capital Projects update at the Board of Supervisor’s annual retreats on January 24, 2023 in Martinez; January 30, 2024 in Pittsburg; January 28, 2025 in San Ramon; and finally, February 3, 2026 in Antioch.

The County has also actively solicited input and participated in meetings with your elected leadership, your two predecessors, and City staff regarding this project on October 11, 2024; May 30, 2025; June 27, 2025; September 2, 2025; October 1, 2025; November 17, 2025; November 19, 2025; and finally again on January 27, 2026 and have incorporated feedback received from City Councilmembers and staff into our design changes.

The East County Service Center Project is on schedule for groundbreaking in early spring 2026. Please feel free to reach out to me if you have any questions or would like to discuss further.
