Roll Call and Introductions

Jeff Landau:

Shared two legal system updates: CA Supreme Ct (Kowalczyk) reinforced the Humphrey decision on bail reform and addresses who can be released pre-trial. New bail requirements that challenge the no-cash bail premise of Humphrey decision.

1172.1 is rolling out in CCC. We have AB 600 that allows judicial initiated resentencing. We currently have prosecution resentencing. Now Court has an avenue to resentence. But the process for judges to consider if a past sentence was unjust isn't being utilized. Different counties are implementing it differently.

Staff proposed forming two ad hoc committees—one focused on the report and another on future community events—with draft materials targeted for review at the July CEF meeting.
