WHEREAS, Contra Costa Community Awareness Emergency Response Group - CAER - is sponsoring the 24th Annual Shelter-in-Place Drill and assisting schools and childcare centers with their emergency preparedness; and


WHEREAS, emergency response agencies including fire, sheriff and health officials all recommend Shelter-in-Place as the immediate action to take in case of a hazardous release; and

WHEREAS, the Shelter-in-Place Drill increases public awareness about Shelter-in-Place is a protective action and gives students and teachers practice in implementing this important procedure; and

WHEREAS, the County Office of Education has endorsed the Shelter-in-Place Drill and encouraged all sites to participate.






