1. Call to Order/Roll Call/Pledge of Allegiance

2. **Public Comment:** A member of the public asked about food truck regulations and asked for a future presentation from the County Health Department to inform the community. George informed the community about a Biz week meeting on May 21st from 10am-1pm. A member of the public shared information about an upcoming meeting to provide input on raising the street sweeper cost to residents. He stated they are ineffective due to the amount of cars parked curbside in Bay Point.

4. **Approval of Minutes** – Motion to approve minutes by Member Lessley, second by Member Tremaine motion carried 7/0

5. Agency Reports

- a. **Contra Costa Sheriff's Office – Deputy Diaz** – Shared that vandalism is slightly up in Bay Point. The Bike Rodeo was somewhat smaller this year due to the weather so almost every kid got a bike. They participated in clean up day which went well, they noticed dumping on Evora was somewhat increased.

- b. **Contra Costa Code Enforcement - Joe Losado** – Joe shared that they opened 49 cases, closed 26 with 111 current. They are hoping to get three possible new hires which will

help.

- c. **Contra Costa Fire – Michelle Rinehart** – Michelle shared information about fire trail maintenance. She also shared concerns about fireworks and where are they coming from. She gave us information about the Wildlife Mitigation Program. She encouraged residents to look at map they have online to know what area you live in for evacuation purposes.
- d. **Golden State Water – Tina Gonzalez** – Tina reported that they are taking care of weed abatement and have projects starting the Willow Pass Extension and Alves. They will be doing valve replacements.
- e. **Supervisor Shanelle Scales-Preston – Armando** – reminded everyone who attended the Keller Fund conference that proposals are due at the end of the month. The community clean up went well and was over early as all containers were filled.

6. Items for Discussion

- a. **The Bay Church – Dr. Paul Long** – Dr. Long gave an update to the MAC about the many services they provide to the Bay Point community. They call their program Bay Compassion Care they want to meet the needs of the whole community not just their members. They offer assistance with food, showers, and youth activities. He encouraged the community to visit and share their thoughts on what other needs we might have.
