**If you are a victim of interpersonal violence (IPV)  
At each Family Justice Center has a team of Navigators who are trained and culturally competent in addressing your needs. They serve as your single and trusted point of contact as they help assist you in removing barriers and connecting with a wide range of resources and partnering agencies.  
Navigators will work with each case to complete a comprehensive needs and risk assessment, and to identify the goals and outcomes that each family would like to achieve.**

Navigators identify current needs and short-term assistance but also analyze the possible long-term support.

Enrolling a client in a long-term safety program is essential to their wellbeing by having their continuous involvement.



# Referral Process

---



Any location welcomes walk-ins to either be navigated in the moment or to schedule a future appointment



Anyone that has experienced IPV can call to schedule an appointment with a Navigator in-person or through phone.

If someone is calling to refer someone else, there must be consent to contact.



Anyone can email any of the navigators, center directors to refer a client if consent has been given to contact client.
