2025 WORK PLAN

The Commission will continue to report to the Ad Hoc Committee on Sustainability, as well as to the full Board. Projects and initiatives related to the Climate Action Plan on which the Commission anticipates it may advise the Board of Supervisors and staff include:

- Implementation of the County's 2024 Climate Action Plan,
- Issues in the Climate Action Plan, including water conservation and drought; land use and public transportation, including pedestrian and bicycle access; energy efficiency and renewable energy; and recycling and composting,
- Implementation of the Climate Emergency Resolution,
- Increasing resilience to climate-related disasters and incidents, including the Adapting to Rising Tides studies for Eastern Contra Costa County and the Bay Area region, wildfires, and Public Safety Power Shutoffs,
- Review of Just Transition Economic Revitalization Plan,
- Electric Vehicle Readiness Implementation,
- Advocacy on issues related to the Climate Action Plan,
- Potential health impacts of climate change (i.e., wildfires),
- All-Electric Buildings for new and existing buildings,
- · Low-carbon concrete building materials,
- Tree planting and preservation policies and actions,
- Carbon Capture and Sequestration, and
- Outreach and education on sustainability to Contra Costa County residents and businesses.
