Member Woo reported that the Nurse Nav call triage program for medical calls went live at 0900 today. The first call came in and was deemed successful.

- -CCCEMSA Prehospital Care Coordinator (PHCC) Christy Hollis gave a brief presentation on the Trauma system of care, and CE Provider Program.
- -CCCEMSA Prehospital Care Coordinator (PHCC) Michelle Voos gave a brief presentation on the MCI Program, and use of Reddinet.
- 7. Fire Chiefs' Report Fire Executive Chief Representative

8. Quarterly 911 Transport Providers Report - Chief Xon Burris CCCFPD, Chief Lance Maples SRVFPD

Chief Burris (CCCFPD):

- -Nurse Nav kicked off at 0900 today. The first call came in and was deemed successful. A Nurse Nav team is onsite at Comms Center to ensure kick off goes as smoothly as possible.
- -There is a new Healthcare Literacy Council that started in May. It is a program to educate the public on the 911 system and effectively navigating healthcare resources with the ultimate goal of reducing unnecessary ED usage and improving community outcomes. The program is currently focused on East County.
- -Contra Costa College Paramedic Program is starting a third cohort in August. The biggest challenge of the program is clinical placement.
- -For the Alliance, there has been good response time compliance at 90% across all zones since the last meeting. Looking to deploy the BLS tiered response into Zone B (West County excluding Richmond) with a target date of July 1st. The timing will allow communication with El Cerrito and Crockett Fire to address any concerns.
- -AMR's paramedic scholarship initiative is starting to reach full maturity. AMR is looking to be fully staffed with paramedics by August.
- -For radio reprogramming, EBRCS XCC fleet map is being updated this month.

9. EMS Medical Director's Report - Senai Kidane, MD, Contra Costa EMS Medical Director

-The bulk of the annual CCCEMSA Field Treatment Guideline update process is complete for this year. The updated field treatment guidelines are currently out for public comment. All are encouraged to provide public comments.

10. EMS Director's Report - Marshall Bennett, Contra Costa EMS Director

- -CCCEMSA continues to work with the State EMS Authority (EMSA) on EMS Plan submission and the RFP that was submitted on February 5th of this year. Conflict over exclusivity in ERA IV is the reason the EMS Plan is not currently approved, and EMSA will not approve the RFP without an approved EMS Plan. Because CCCEMSA does not have an approved RFP from EMSA, the current EOA contract for ERAs I, II, and V will need to be extended.
- -During the March EMCC meeting, there was a discussion over response volume data in the system, the issue is now resolved. The FirstWatch generated report that CCCEMSA references was incorrect and did not account for some BLS calls.
- -CCCEMSA has several policies that will be coming out soon for public comment; these will include a managing assaultive behavior policy and declining treatment/transport policy.
- -CCCEMSA will be releasing a memorandum soon that will detail the sunset of a 2022 COVID era memo that allows for BLS response to law enforcement requests for non-medical behavioral transport.

11. The next meeting is currently scheduled for September 9, 2025.

Members requested an agenda item on A3 program.

Advisory Body + Brown Act done

Meeting Attendance Requirements per the Bylaws:

- A. EMCC members shall attend EMCC meetings.
 B. A member who cannot attend a meeting must notify the Chair and may have one excused absence in a twelve month period.

 C. Whenever a member does not attend two regularly scheduled meetings, within a rolling twelve
- month period, complete their Brown Act requirements or fails to meet the criteria for sitting on the advisory body the EMS Agency shall notify the nominating agency/organization of the
- absences and request appropriate action.

 D. Members must complete the required Ethics and Brown Act training provided by the County within three months of appointment and submit the "Training Certification for Member of
- County Advisory Body" form to EMS staff prior to participating at any meeting.

 E. Members who do not complete the Ethics and Brown Act training within 3 months may not further participate until the requirement is fulfilled.
- F. Ethics and Brown Act training is recommended to be completed every two years while serving on a County Advisory Committee.
