Growing Healthy Kids	<p>Growing Healthy Kids is a school-based program that supports student health, learning, and engagement through outdoor education, nutrition learning, and increased access to fresh food. The program uses hands-on garden and outdoor learning experiences to help students build knowledge and skills related to healthy eating and food systems.</p> <p>The project increases student access to fresh, locally grown produce through school gardens, farm stands, and food distribution activities. It also supports classroom and outdoor instruction that encourages students to try new foods and understand the importance of nutrition in their daily lives.</p> <p>Through experiential learning, students develop stronger connections to their environment, improve decision-making around food choices, and engage more actively in their education. The program is designed to support healthier students, increased engagement in school, and improved educational outcomes.</p> <p>Growing Healthy Kids integrates outdoor education, nutrition learning, and increased access to fresh food to support healthier, more engaged students and improved educational outcomes in Bay Point schools.</p>	\$10,000
Team Jesus	<p>Team Jesus Outreach Ministries is a community-based organization focused on providing food support and basic assistance to individuals and families in need. The program delivers food distribution and outreach services that include access to perishable and non-perishable food items, helping to address food insecurity in the community. Through ongoing outreach efforts, the organization serves vulnerable populations, including low-income households</p>	\$20,000

	<p>and individuals experiencing hardship, by increasing access to essential resources and support services.</p> <p>Team Jesus Outreach Ministries needs a new commercial refrigerator to support its community food service efforts. The refrigerator will provide cold storage for perishable food items distributed to individuals and families in need. This equipment will increase the organization’s capacity to safely store and handle donated food and support ongoing outreach activities.</p>
