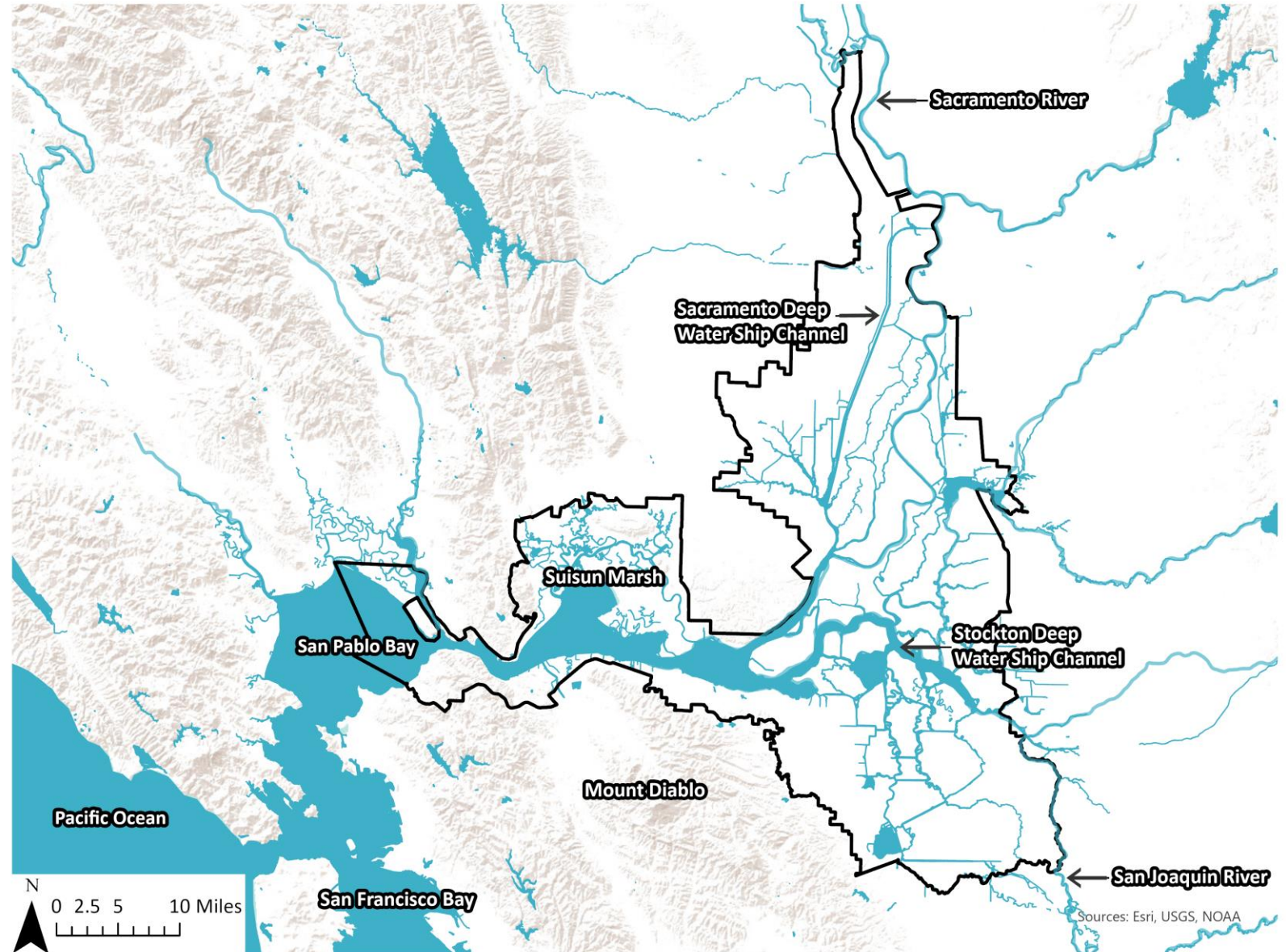

What is a National Heritage Area?

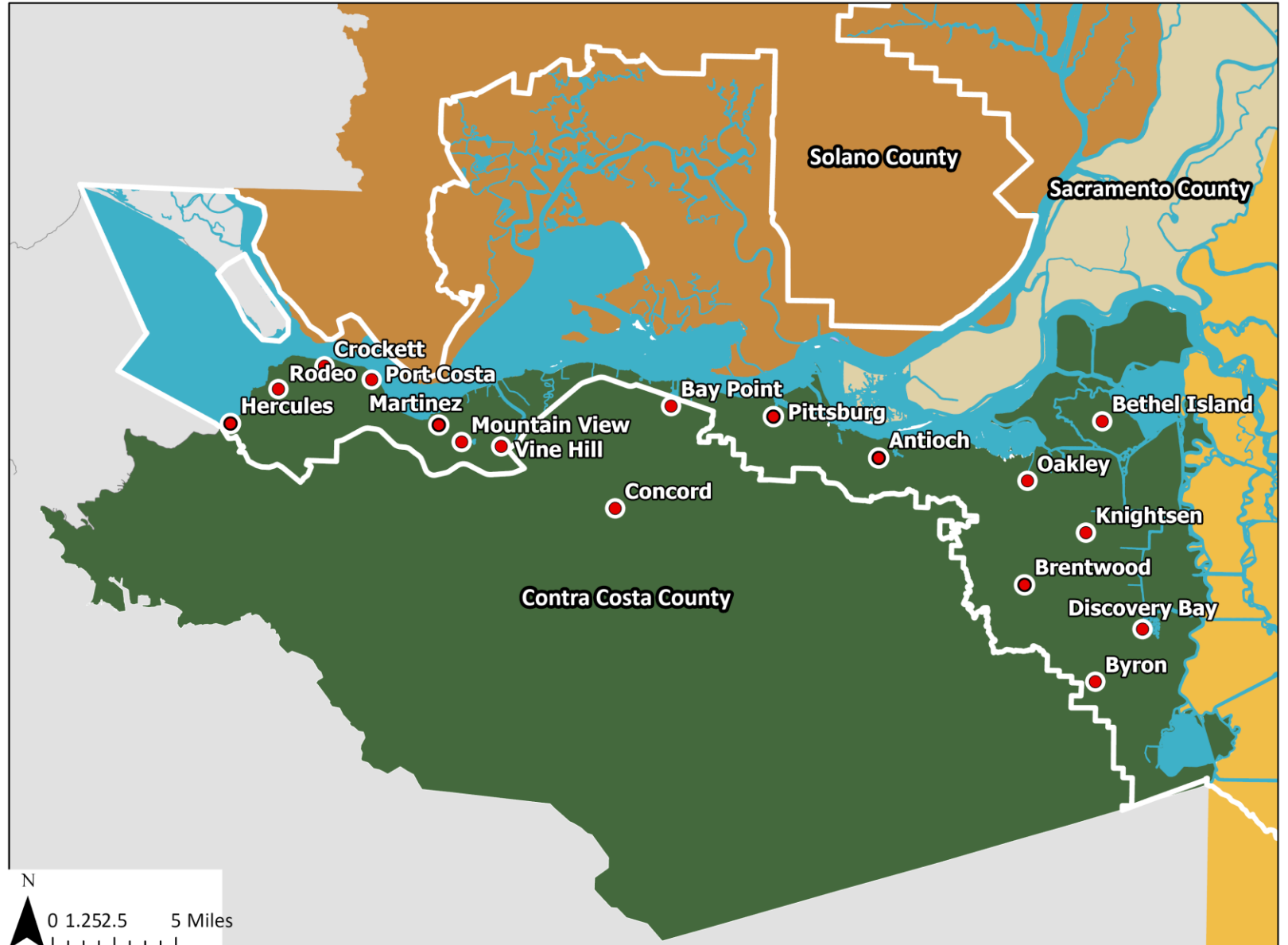
