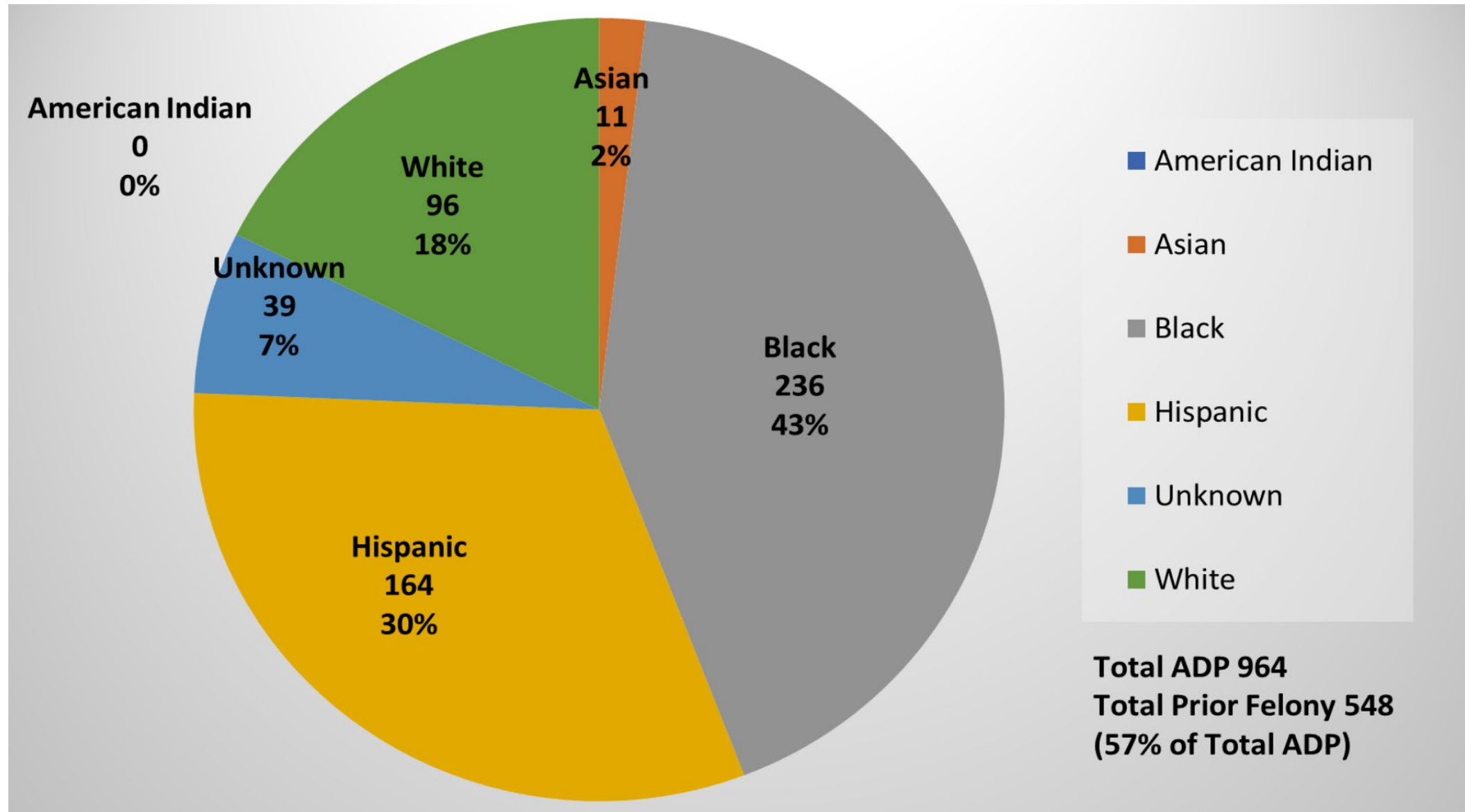

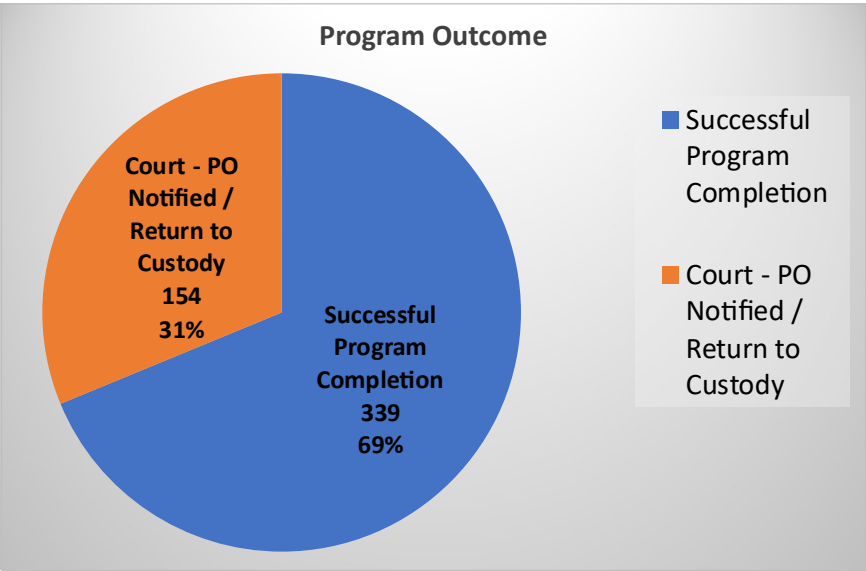
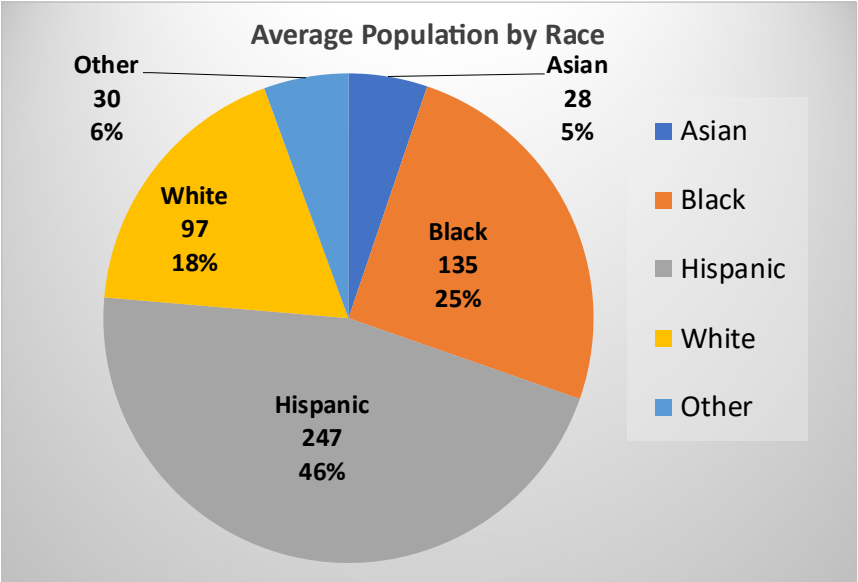

Board of State & Community Corrections (BSCC)

An Unannounced Inspection of the Contra Costa County Sheriff's Office was completed for West County Detention Facility (WCDF) on Saturday, March 7, 2026.

This inspection was conducted pursuant to Penal Code Section 6031 to determine compliance with the Minimum Standards for Local Detention Facilities as outlined in Titles 15 and 24, California Code of Regulations.

No items of non-compliance were found by the BSCC inspector.

Prison Law Office

On February 28, 2021, the Court approved a consent decree between Contra Costa County & the Prison Law Office to evaluate and enhance services in the Martinez & West County detention facilities.

That consent decree ended on time on Feb 28, 2026, without any litigation. This accomplishment was only possible through the excellent teamwork and collaboration between County Counsel, Health Services and the Office of the Sheriff.

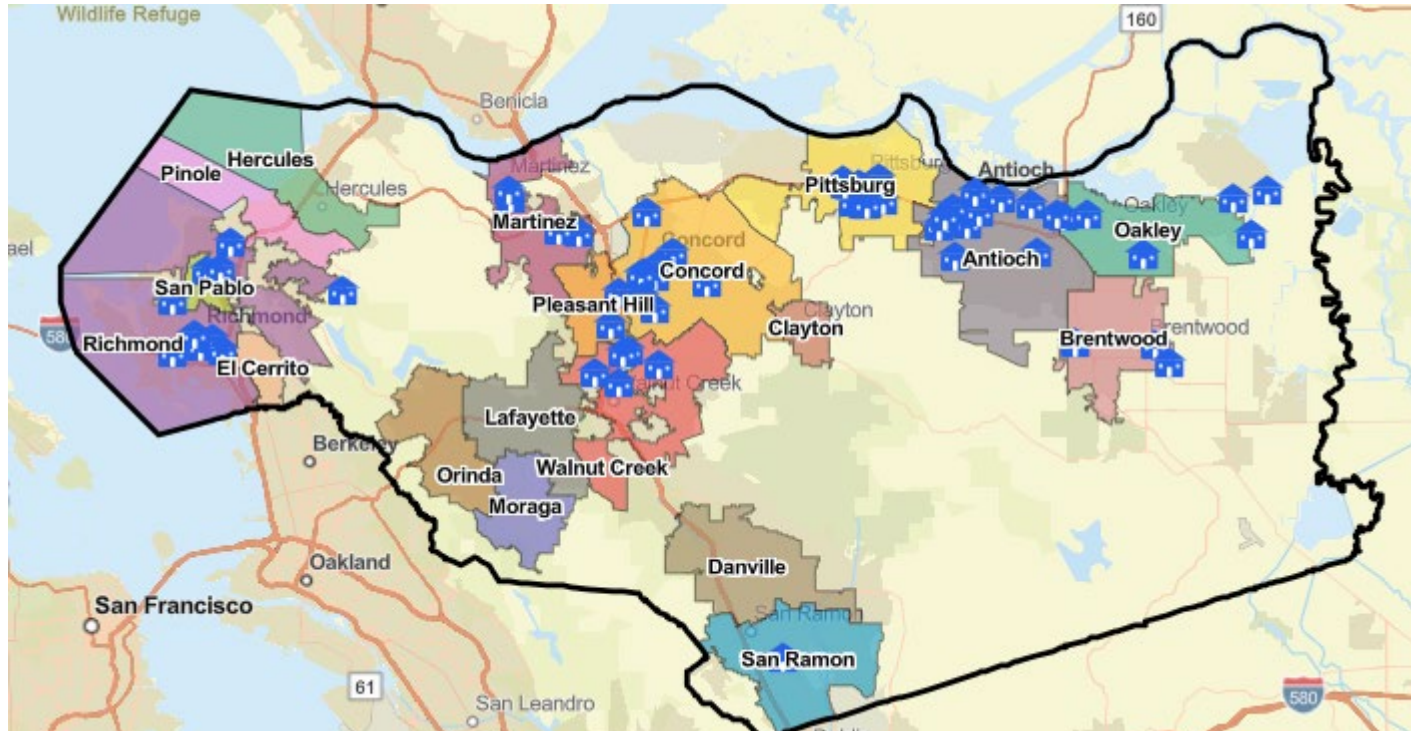

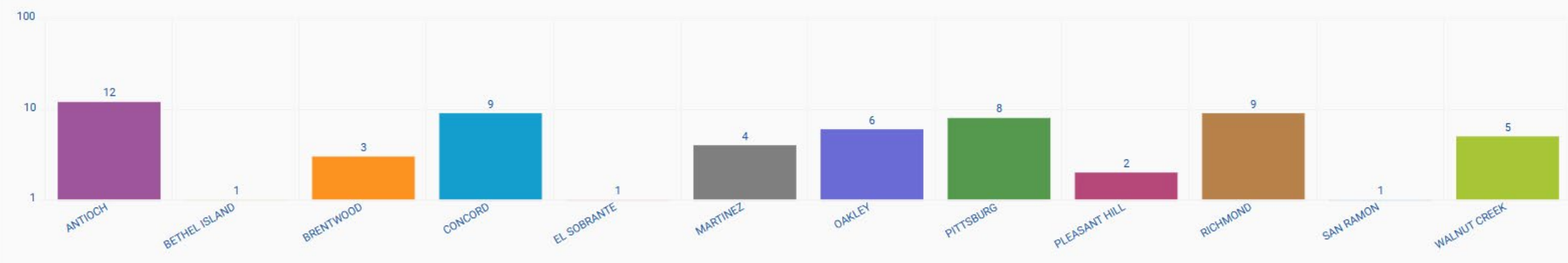

California Peace Officer Standards and Training Basic Course Certification Review (BCCR)

The Contra Costa County Office of the Sheriff Law Enforcement Training Center (LETC) successfully completed the Basic Course Certification Review (BCCR), conducted by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST).

The LETC was commended for upholding high standards in both training and safety. Over the past three years, more than 90% of graduates from the Contra Costa County Law Enforcement Training Center have remained employed as Peace Officers in California, reflecting a retention rate above the state average.

At the Contra Costa County Office of the Sheriff, we are dedicated to serving our diverse community with integrity, professionalism, and accountability. Our mission - to work in partnership with the community to safeguard lives, rights, and property through innovative and ethical law enforcement - guides everything we do.

Transparency Portal Update

- Transparency Portal dashboards went live April 2, 2026.
- There are currently 26 dashboards with dashboards also translated to Spanish, Hindi, and Chinese.
- The dashboards contain digitized data historically reported in the Quarterly Sheriff's Oversight Reports, along with additional data now presented in an interactive format.
- Between April 2 and April 22, 2026, there were 137 users with 1,764 dashboard views.

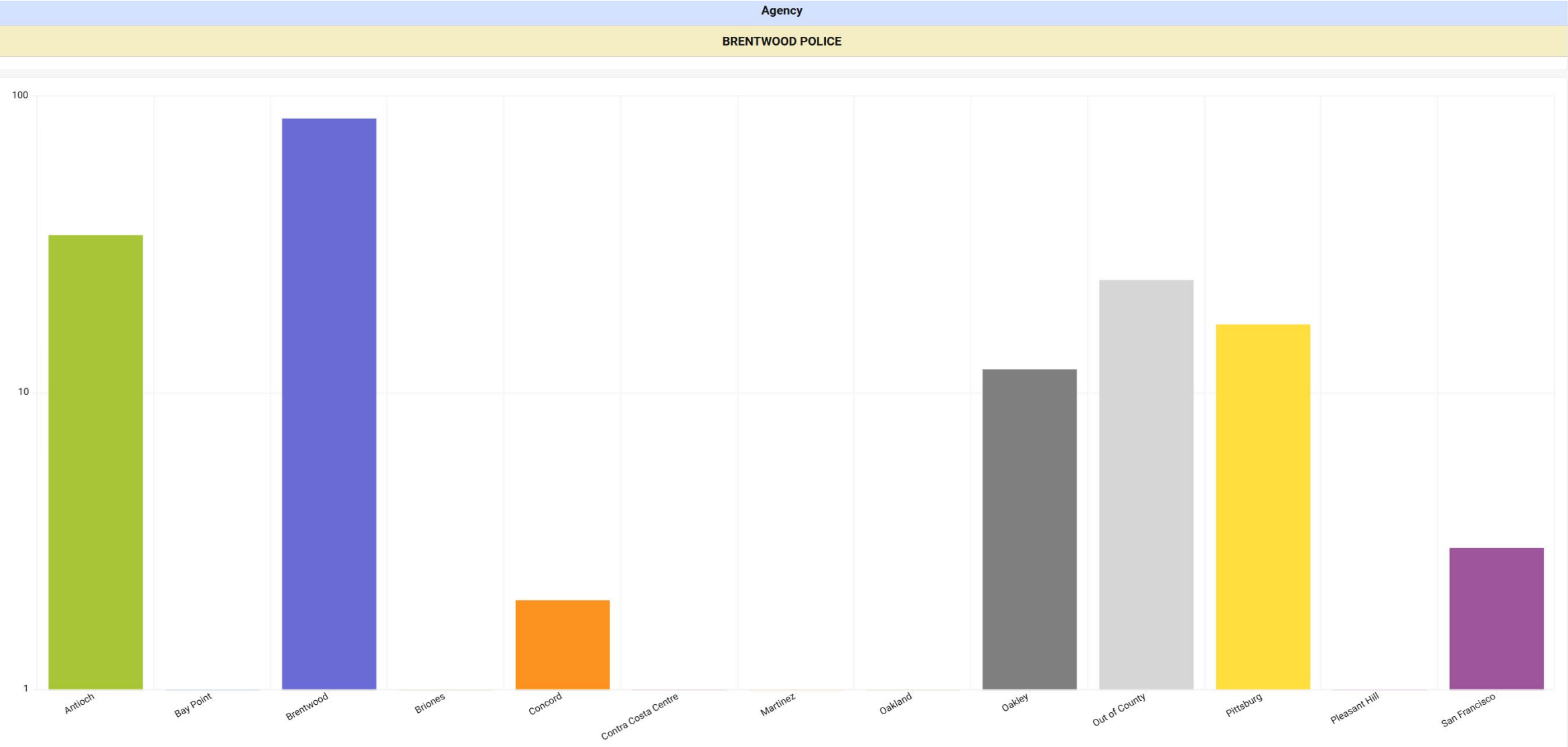
Arrest Data by City of Residence



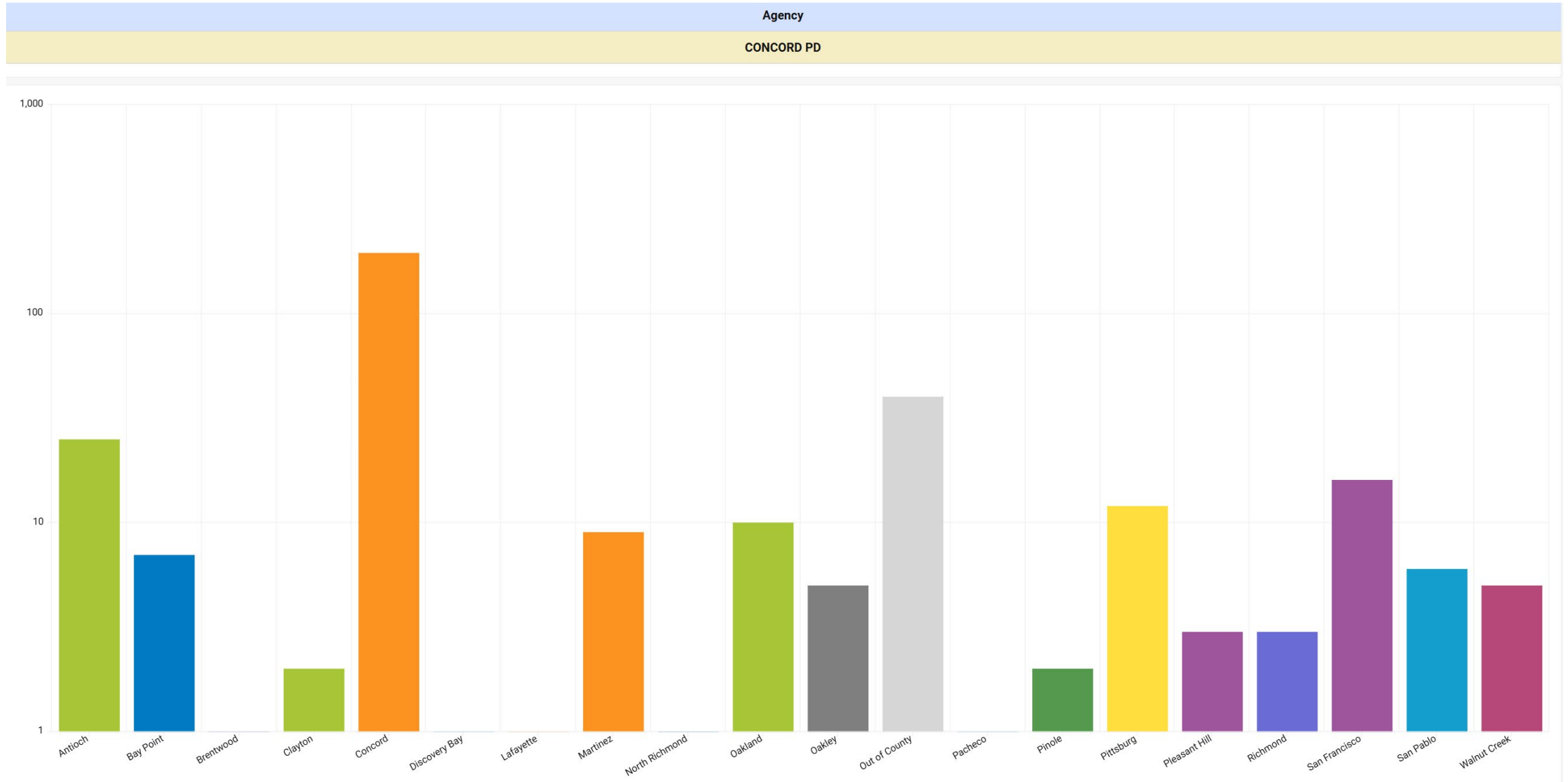
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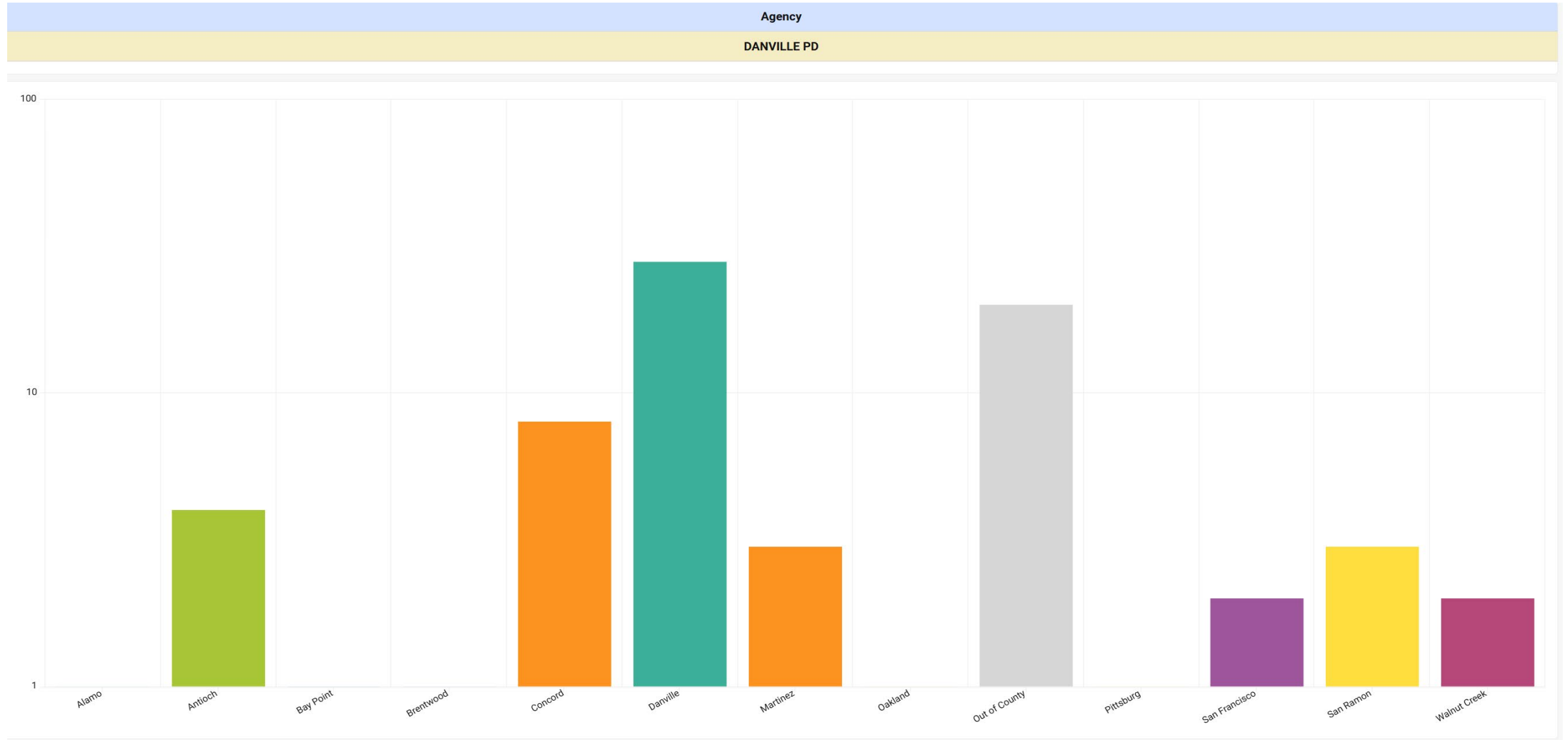
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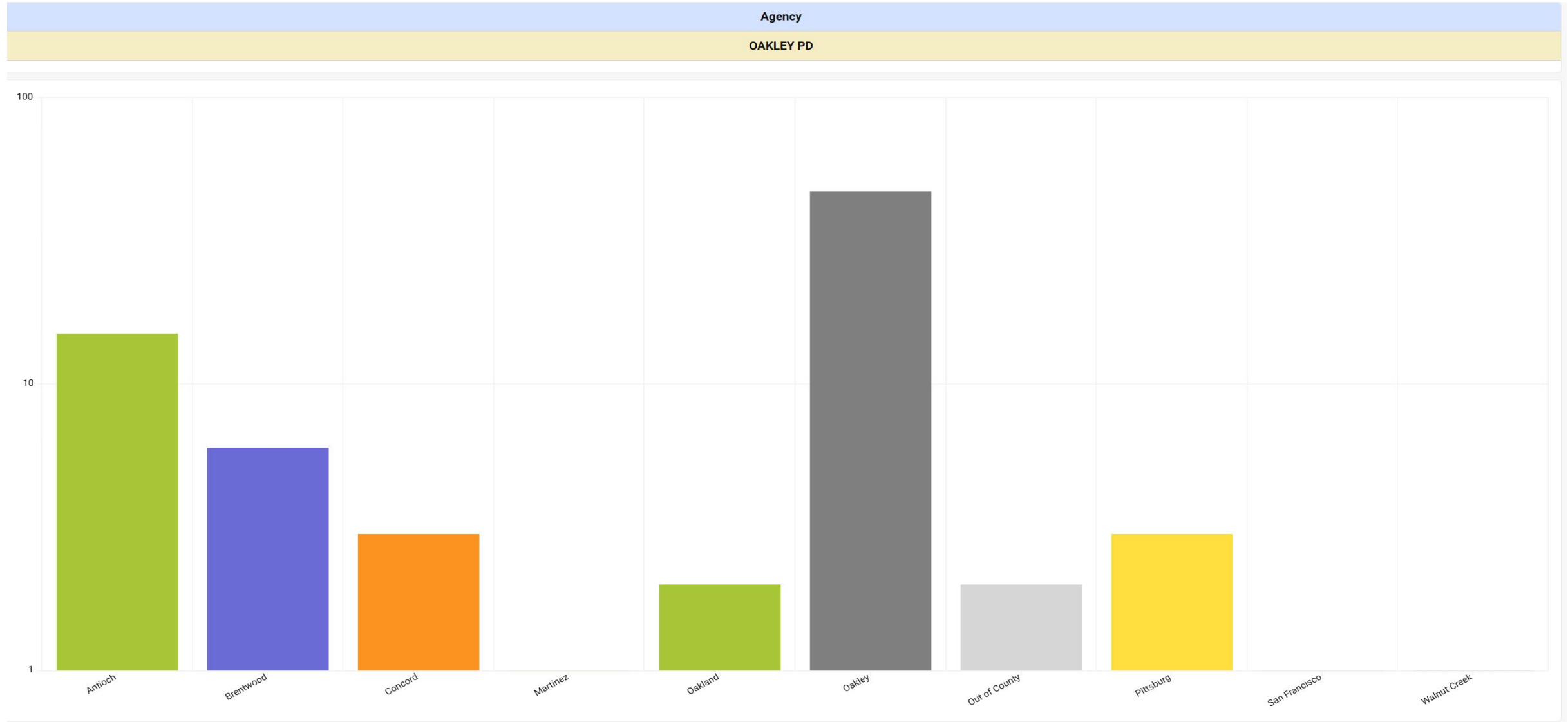
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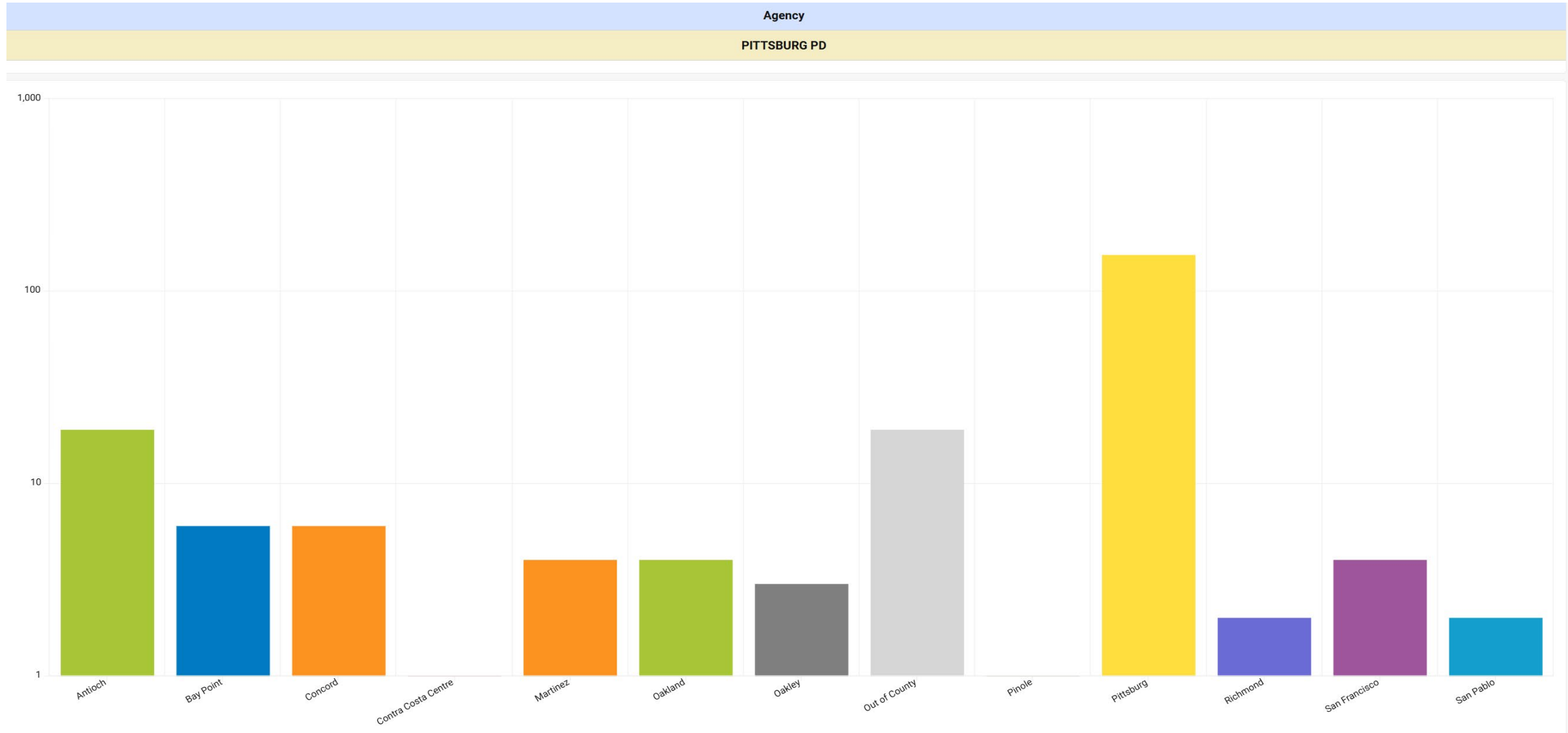
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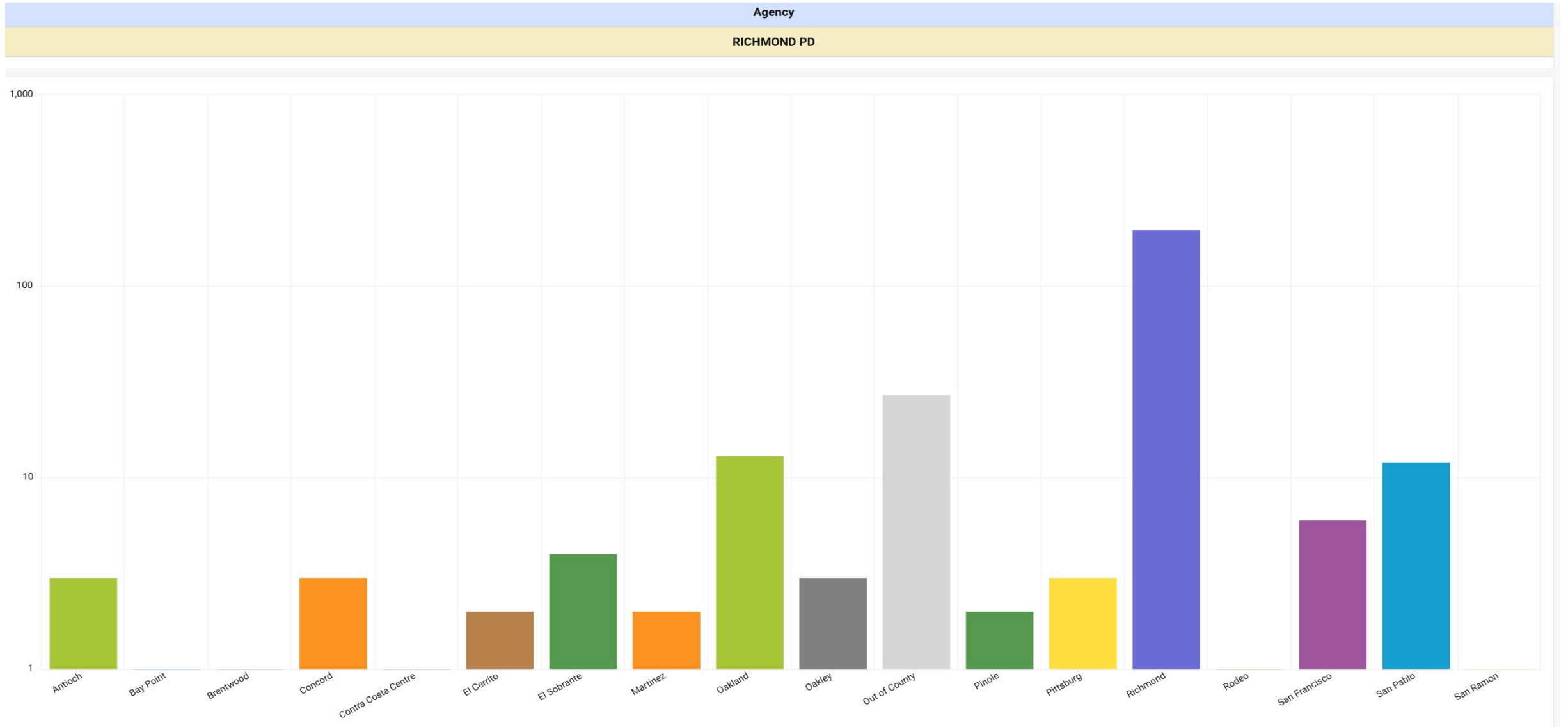
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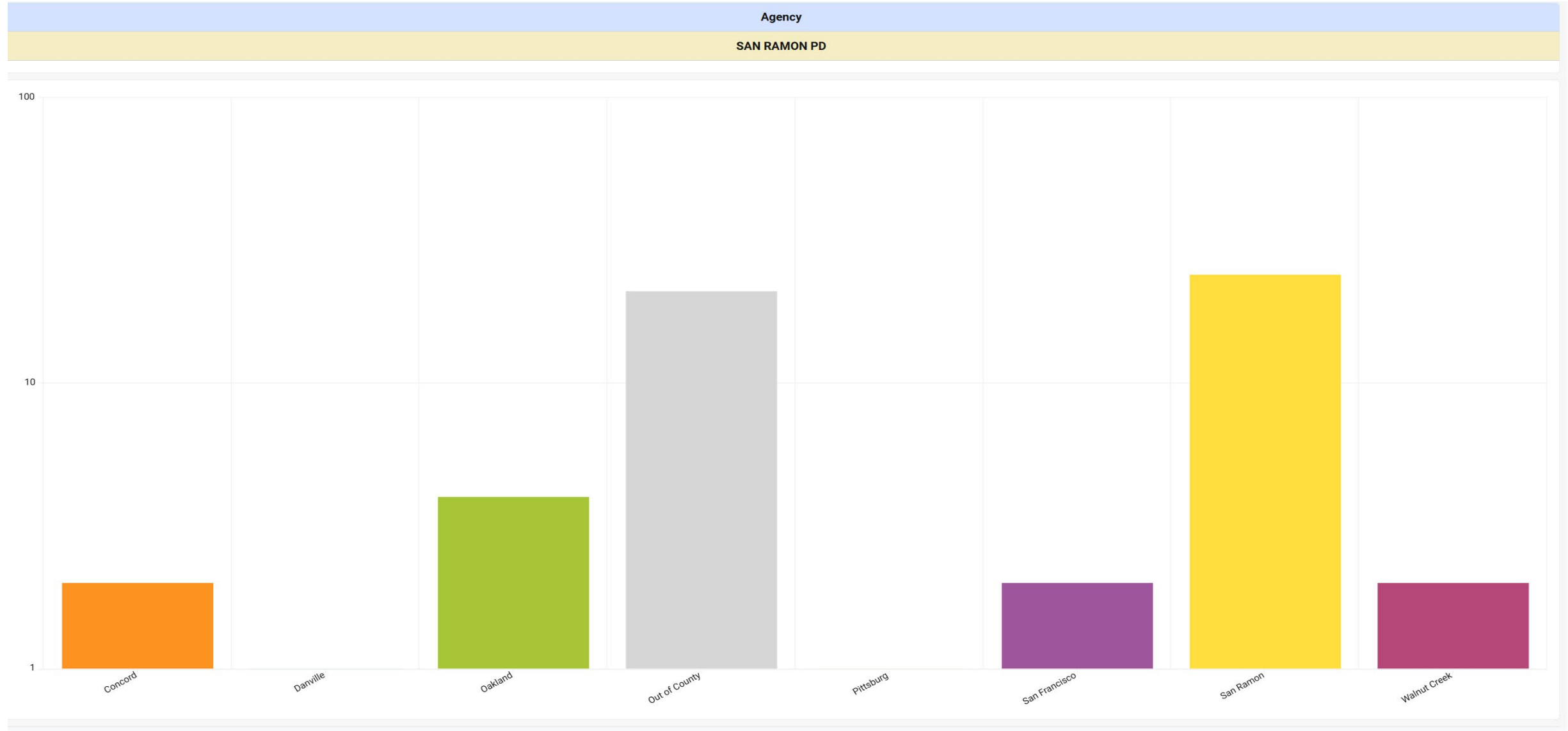
