



TREATMENT PROGRAMS FOR THE TARGET POPULATION

The “target population” is defined as “youth who were eligible for commitment to the Division of Juvenile Justice prior to its closure and shall further be defined as persons who are adjudicated to be a ward of the juvenile court based on an offense described in subdivision (b) of Section 707 or an offense described in Section 290.008 of the Penal Code.




- Briones Youth Academy Secure Track






ETHNICITY AND REGION OF COUNTY

LENGTH OF STAY







THE HAVEN

The Haven is a Multi-Sensory De-escalation Room (MSDR) that creates a safe, trauma-informed environment that allows youth to de-escalate independently. The MSDR provides the youth an opportunity to remove themselves from their normal environment and separate themselves from other youth who may be triggering to them.







Tamalpais Unit
