### Would You Like to Serve on the Advisory Fire Commission?

(Martinez, CA) – The Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors is seeking individuals to serve as an At Large member and an At Large Alternate member of the Contra Costa County Fire Protection District's (CCCFPD) Advisory Fire Commission. The Commission is responsible for confirming cost of abatement reports; conducting weed abatement appeal hearings; approving surplus equipment declarations; and advising the Fire Chief on District service matters. The Commission also serves as a liaison between the Board of Directors and the community and may be asked to perform other duties by the Board of Directors.

To be eligible for the At Large appointment, applicants must reside within the boundaries of the former East Contra Costa Fire Protection District (Brentwood, Oakley, Discovery Bay, Bethel Island, Knightsen, Byron).

To be eligible for the At Large Alternate appointment, applicants must reside within the boundaries of the former Rodeo-Hercules Fire Protection District.

Regular meetings of the Advisory Fire Commission are currently held on the second Monday of even-numbered months at 7:00 p.m. in Concord. The appointments will be for a four-year term, beginning July 1, 2026, and ending on June 30, 2030. Commissioners are not compensated.
