Description: Contra Costa County on June 22, 2021 contracted with Granite Construction Company for work generally consisting at the Alhambra Valley Road at Ferndale site, construction of a soldier pile retaining wall, drainage improvements, guardrail and vegetation control, and reconstruction of the roadway. At the Alhambra Valley Road West of Castro Ranch Road site, work included remedial grading and reconstruction of the embankment, construction of guardrail and vegetation control, and reconstruction of the roadway. At Bear Creek Road, there are two sites, 3A and 3B. At site 3A, work included construction of a soldier pile retaining wall, drainage improvements, guardrail and vegetation control, and reconstruction of the roadway. At site 3B, work included remedial grading and reconstruction of the embankment, construction of guardrail and vegetation control, and reconstruction of the roadway, all in accordance with the plans, drawings, special provisions and/or specifications prepared by or for the Public Works Director and in accordance with the accepted bid proposal. The project was located in the Briones, Pinole, and Alhambra Valley areas, with the Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America, as surety, for work to be performed on the grounds of the County; and


