**RAPID RESPONSE/OUTPLACEMENT SERVICES**

Since November 2025, the following businesses submitted WARN notices. The notices may include companies located outside Contra Costa County if a remote worker was affected and resides in the County. The WDBCCC Rapid Response Coordinator provided each employer with information about outplacement services and transition resources, including unemployment insurance information, affordable health care options, employment training opportunities, and other supportive services for impacted workers. Rapid Response orientations, either in-person and/or virtual, were also offered for Employers experiencing significant layoffs.
