

This Indenture made the twelfth day of August A.D. 1858
 Between August Bowers Henry Cook and Emerette
 Cook his wife Henry Drevits and J. M. Drevits his
 wife and John Lattimore parties of the first part and
 Contra Costa County California party of the second
 part Witnesseth that the parties of the first part in
 consideration of one dollar to them paid do hereby
 release and forever quitclaim unto Contra Costa County
 for the use of a Public Road or Highway all that certain
 strip or parcel of land lying and being in Township Number
 two County and State aforesaid. Commencing at a point
 on a line between August Bowers and Joseph
 Allamedas land from which Bowers house bears
 S 40° W and Allamedas house bears N 41° E about
 15 chs distant. Variation 16° 55' East Thence S 36°
 N 13.50 chs N 81° W 11.90 chs to a line between Bowers
 and Lattimore, Thence N 87° W 38.10 chs to a line
 between Lattimore and Cook, Thence S 71½° W 20.00
 chs to a line between Cook and Drevits Thence S 12° E
 6.05 chs, S 63¾° W 12.00 chs, N 80½° W 50 chs N 83¾°
 W 6.40 chs, S 74¾° W 3.00 chs S 54° W 4.30 chs,
 S 56¾° W 2.70 chs to East line of Mary Ann Smiths
