SUBJECT: 2025 Dougherty Valley Traffic Level-of-Service (LOS) Monitoring Report

Pursuant to the terms of the Dougherty Valley Settlement Agreement, the Town is pleased to provide traffic level-of-service data ("LOS") for the Camino Tassajara/Crow Canyon Road/Blackhawk Road intersection within the Town of Danville.

LOS is calculated using the Contra Costa Transportation Authority's ("Authority") CCTALOS methodology and is consistent with the methodology used to evaluate the Town's compliance with the Authority's Growth Management Program requirements. The 2025 LOS calculations are based on turning movement counts obtained for a Level of Service analysis completed November 7, 2025. As reference, included are historical LOS reporting for the subject intersection.
