WHEREAS, Nepal Day is observed on or around April 14 of each year as the Nepali New Year according to the Nepali calendar; and

WHEREAS, Contra Costa County is a diverse community that values inclusion and cultural heritage, and proudly recognizes the contributions of the Nepali community throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, Nepali community organizations throughout Contra Costa County serve residents by promoting cultural awareness, community connection, and preservation of Nepali traditions and values; and


