1. Open the meeting

Carl Roner noted that there are ways to implement these sort of project through existing agreements between the County and Cities/Towns.

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Carl Roner provided the current list of IHC projects and their status, including the Kinder Morgan Release in Walnut Creek, which will implement a new remediation methos this summer.

Chris Weeks from the City of San Ramon provided a brief update on the status of the Bollinger Canyon Pedestrian Bridge.

Carl Roner provided an update on the San Ramon Double Tracking Project, which is currently approaching the 65% design stages.

Carl Roner provided a brief report on the California Trails and Greenways Conference.

The next meeting date is August 10, 2026. Topics to be discussed include the status of San Ramon Double Tracking Project and the efforts by the Contra Costa Transit Authority to plan a connector trail from the north end of the Iron Horse Corridor, near Marsh Drive, to the Canal Trail.
