
WHEREAS, in addition, he has volunteered with Global Glimpse, which helps build schools and homes in underserved communities while developing global awareness and leadership skills; and

PASSED by a unanimous vote of the Board of Supervisors members present this 14th day of April 2026.







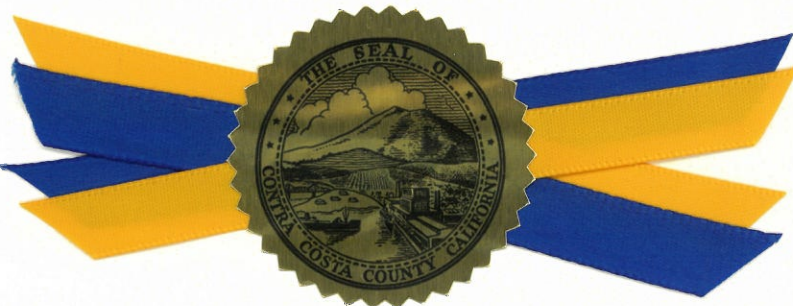
