# Blackhawk Police Services

## Summary for March 2026

Blackhawk and Valley Station Deputies either initiated or responded to the following calls for service:

- 599 ~ Total calls for service in Blackhawk
- 5 ~ Total police reports were taken in Blackhawk

**Felonies** – There was 1 felony reported in the District.

- On March 6, 2026, a resident reported a fraudulent electronic funds transfer from their American Express Business line of credit. American Express's fraud protection team froze the transaction while it conducts an investigation. The case has been referred to the Investigation Division and remains under investigation.

**Misdemeanors** – There was 1 misdemeanor reported in the District.

- On March 16, 2026, a resident reported that an unknown person attempted to open a PayPal credit account using their personal identifying information. No card was issued, and the account was closed. The investigation is ongoing.

**Arrests** – There were no arrests in the District for the month.

## Incidents of Interest

- On March 20, 2026, the Blackhawk deputy, along with several deputies from Valley Station and SRVF, responded at approximately 9:30 p.m. to a residence near Quail Run Court for a report of a person in mental health crisis who had armed themselves with a knife. Upon arrival, deputies de-escalated the situation, and the individual was transported by ambulance to PES for treatment.

## Volunteers in Policing

- Our four volunteers provided 15 hours of volunteer work throughout the month. The volunteers provided routine security checks, to include numerous Vacation House Checks, and provided extra patrol vehicle presence throughout the community.

- While Blackhawk remains one of the safest communities in California, property crimes still occur. Since the beginning of the year, there have been two residential burglaries. Please consider the following steps to help protect your home and family. Set your alarm before leaving, regardless of how long you will be away. Lock all doors and windows. At night, leave lights on or a television running to create the appearance that someone is home. If you have a video surveillance system, consider using cloud storage. In many cases, suspects gain entry by breaking a rear glass door. Additional measures to consider include installing motion-activated lighting, glass-break sensors, and impact-resistant or laminated glass. Any steps taken to better secure and reinforce your home can help reduce the risk of burglary.
