Discussion:

The group discussed developing a more strategic and sustainable community engagement plan by partnering with community-based organizations (CBOs), leveraging existing

networks, events, and communication channels, and coordinating with other county efforts to reduce duplication. Members emphasized clarifying RJOB's priorities, assessing CBO needs, and strengthening RJOB's role as a conduit for community voices while highlighting the County's progress and identifying opportunities for broader collaboration and outreach.

Probation created a courtyard focused on family engagement. Probation also just released a new data dashboard dedicated to Juvenile Justice programs and services.

Sheriff has also released a new data dashboard that includes much of the info included in their quarterly report to BOS.

Office of Ed celebrated graduates from their programs. Students in juvenile hall are receiving HS diplomas, college credits and workforce training. Detention populations are on the decline.

DVC is providing more resources, such as free tuition, job training, and placement support, to CJ impacted students. Also programming around truck driving certification. Possibly some resources at Los Medanos and CCC.

Grace Bible has a “Juneteen” event happening this weekend focused on “teens” and young people (6/13 at Grace Bible Fellowship in Antioch, all day).
