RE: Marine Trades Skills Training and Waterfront Transportation Careers Annual Report



Workforce Development Board of Contra Costa County (WDBCCC)'s Workforce Accelerator Fund 11 (WAF 11) Marine Trades Skills Training (MTST) officially closed on April 30, 2025. Awarded \$500,000 from the California Workforce Development Board, the program enrolled 31 people with a 94% completion rate from June 2023 to March 2025, distributing \$54,000 in stipends to participants. efforts Recruitment targeted communities lacking exposure, access, and opportunities in the maritime

industry. Through a 10-week curriculum, participants gained introductory skills as marine painters, machinists, carpenters, and welders. The program included safety certifications, hands-on experience, personal and professional development, and comprehensive supportive services. While the WAF-funded program has concluded, the training model lives on through collaboration. An expanded initiative, the Marine Trades and Waterfront Transportation Careers (MTWTC), is now underway in Alameda County, supported by California's High Roads Training Partnership (HRTP). This continuation ensures the region will maintain a pipeline for maritime workforce development via our partnership with workforce development boards of Alameda County and Oakland.
