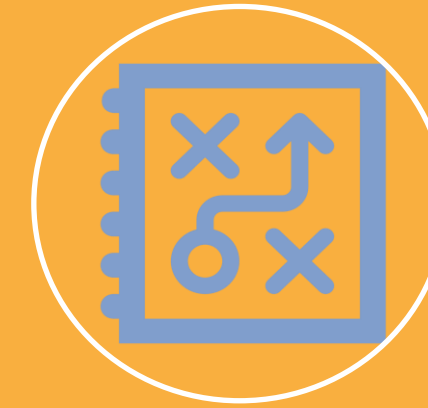
CCC Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance 2017-16

- Regulates the collection and transport non-franchise solid waste haulers.



Environmental Health facilitates the program

- Requires haulers to obtain a permit
- Display permit decals
- Pay regulatory fees



Enforcement Challenges

- Collection is a requirement and must be observed

California Assembly Bill 592

- CCC Board of Supervisors sponsored
- Added Section 21100.6 to the California Vehicle Code.
- Authorizes CCC to create a 3-year pilot program to regulate the transportation of solid waste on public roads.



Regulates Transport of Solid Waste

By commercial nonfranchise solid waste haulers in the unincorporated County.

New Ordinance | Chapter 418-3

Retains Provisions in Chapter 418-2

- Obtain permit
- Display permit decals
- Pay regulatory fees
- Provide insurance & bond info

Solely Regulates Transport

- Due to Vehicle Code Section 21100.6
- Exempts homeowners, contractors, and landscaping companies

Expands Enforceability

- Amends Section 14-8.008
- Authorizes the Office of the Sheriff and Env Health to issue infraction citations

Pilot Program

- Sunsets January 1, 2028, if adopted.
- Require another ordinance if Vehicle Code Section 21100.6 is extended beyond January 1, 2028
