Minutes of Meeting on December 9, 2025

The P-5 Advisory Committee was held at Round Hill Country Club. Jason Hill called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM. The November Minutes were approved by unanimous motion with no corrections.

Public Comment: none

P-5 Activity Report: Deputy Shanks reported that there were no significant incidents in November. Alarm Calls, Area Checks, Patrol Requests and Medical Calls were performed as usual.

In November there were 125 hours of overtime primarily due to the absence of Deputy Smith. Deputy Shanks who has been filling the majority of the overtime hours will get relief as of January 12, 2026 when Deputy Garrett Santiago will become the newest P5 Deputy serving the weekend shift.

There were zero hours of outside assistance in November.

Financial Report: Mark Young Reported that the monthly P5 spending is remaining at the \$54000.00 level. He is forecasting that the Reserve Account at

the end of FY 25/26 is projected to be \$850,000.00 . Deputy Shanks brought up the issue of P5 adding a 2nd police vehicle. His concern centered on the constant use of the current vehicle and the possibility with the consolidation of the Alamo Police Districts of having an on duty Deputy with no police vehicle to use. This issue needs more discussion from both a use case and a financial perspective.

There was continuing discussion about the interest return on funds in the Reserve Account and how the unused P5 tax funds are held. Cameron Collins will revisit with the County as to how these funds are managed and to whose benefit any interest accrues.

Old Business: The meeting with Sheriff Livingston and Candace Andersen to address the consolidation of the Police Districts in Alamo will occur in early January.

New Business: The meeting day will change in 2026 and will be the fourth Monday of the month at Round Hill Country Club. This makes January 26, 2026 at 7:00 PM the first P5 Advisory Committee Meeting of the New Year.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:50
