WHEREAS, David promoted to Senior Engineer Technician in the Design/Construction Division on March 15, 2019; and in September 2024, David was acknowledged by an Alamo resident for his quick actions & coordination with a local utility company to resolve a valve cover in the roadway that was a tripping hazard; and

WHEREAS, In October 2024, David was mentioned for his help in relocating an Oak tree that was set to be removed for an upcoming project; and

WHEREAS, In December 2025, David was mentioned by 3 members of a local utility company about his continued strong support and team effort with them and towards County residents he provides on a daily basis; and

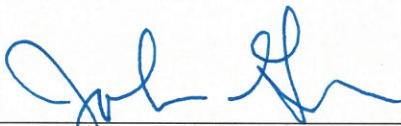
