Garibay: No update from Sheriff's leadership and data teams due to office inundated with other priorities. Will continue to follow up and request feedback.

Landau: Recommend that we include the draft recommendation in subcommittee update to full RJOB in net meeting for discussion

Garibay: Initial thought: The recommendation requesting that disciplinary actions taken on officers who violate will likely not be provided due to legal obligation and confidentiality provisions.

3. REVIEW Data Walk Activity and Summary Report Draft

Johanna Lacoe, CA Policy Lab presented to group an introduction on the work of CPL (Staff will upload the slide deck to next packet)

What CPL would need from RJOB:

- Gather buy-in by partners to share data
- Come up with a research project/question; a causal, impact question (that will drive the work to fund the more descriptive, investigative research)
- CPL is able to craft data sharing agreements, leveraging work already done in CPL/Probation project currently happening
- CPL is also able to warehouse the data in safe, secure database

Members supported bringing the proposal to the full RJOB and emphasized coordinating across subcommittees and CEF, adding context to racial disparities, and using the findings to inform policy, programs, and resource decisions.

Staff presented the updated draft of the Data Walk Summary Report.

See recommendations below (a working draft, taken from the summary report).

Recommendations

As a result of the findings of this report, the Racial Justice Oversight Body identified several trends and metrics that require further analysis. Below is a set of recommendations, that is not exhaustive:

1. An in-depth analysis on the increase in misdemeanor arrests.
2. A cause analysis on the increase in racial disparities in misdemeanor and felony arrests.
3. An additional report on legal system interactions and outcomes for youth.
4. An analysis on the racial breakdown of the pretrial population over time.
5. A county-wide, publicly accessible RIPA dashboard.
6. An analysis on the disproportionate use of force by race, including reason for stop, and if a charge was eventually made.
7. An analysis on the racial breakdown of all police stops in Contra Costa County, the reasons, and resulting action.
8. An analysis on who the District Attorney's office files on or not, including race.
9. An analysis on the time to disposition for Contra Costa County Courts that includes race.
