

**AMENDMENT NO 2. TO  
PARTICIPATING AGREEMENT  
FOR  
MAILING EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES, AND MAINTENANCE**

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Participating Entity:  
**CONTRA COSTA COUNTY**

Contractor: Quadient, Inc.

This Amendment No. 2 (“Amendment”) is entered into as of April 14, 2026 (“Amendment Effective Date”), by and among Contra Costa County, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”), Contra Costa County Fire Protection District, a fire protection district formed under the Fire Protection District Law of 1987, (“District”), Quadient, Inc., a Delaware corporation (“Contractor”), whose principal place of business is 478 Wheelers Farms Rd., Milford, CT 06461, and Quadient Leasing USA, Inc., a California corporation (“Lessor”), whose principal place of business is 478 Wheelers Farms Rd., Milford, CT 06461, to modify the participating addendum (“Agreement”) entered into as of February 6, 2025, by and among the County, the Contractor, and the Lessor. The County, the District, the Contractor, and the Lessor are sometimes referred to herein together as the “Parties,” and each individually as a “Party.” Terms used but not defined in this Amendment shall have the same meaning as the terms have in the Agreement.

Recitals

Whereas, the County, Contractor, and Lessor entered into the Agreement to allow the County to purchase mailing equipment and related supplies and maintenance under the State Addendum, which incorporates the terms of the Master Contract. The Agreement also allows the County to lease and rent certain products and equipment under Lessor’s Government Product Lease Agreement, Postage Meter Rental Agreement, Postage Funding Account Agreement, Maintenance Agreement, and Online Services and Software Agreement, subject to the modifications to those agreements set forth in the Agreement.

Whereas, the District is a public entity separate from the County but governed by the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors, which acts ex officio as the District’s board of directors. The District desires to make purchases under the Agreement, and lease and rent certain products and equipment under the Agreement, on the same terms as the County. The Contractor and Lessor desire to sell certain products and lease and rent certain products and equipment to the District under the Agreement on the same terms as the County.

Amendment

Now, therefore, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, the County, the District, the Contractor, and the Lessor agree to amend the Agreement, as previously amended, as follows:

1. Payment Limit. Section 2 (Payment Limit) of the Agreement is deleted and replaced with new Section 2, to read:

“The total payments to the Contractor under this Agreement shall not exceed \$800,000 (“Payment Limit”), which represents the combined Payment Limit of the County and the District, together. Nothing in this Agreement obligates the County or the District to make any purchases, or any particular volume of purchases, under this Agreement.”

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2. District as a Party. For purchases, rentals, and leases made by the District, or by the County on behalf of the District, each reference in the Agreement to the “County” shall mean the “District.” Each in the Agreement reference to “parties” shall include the District.
3. Notices. Section 16 (Notices) of the Agreement is amended to add contact information for the District, as follows:

4. Remainder Unchanged. Except to the extent that this Amendment expressly modifies the Agreement, as previously amended, the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
