

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act (“TEFRA”)

Notice is hereby given that on Friday, April 4, 2025, the Assistant Deputy Director of the Department of Conservation and Development of the County of Contra Costa (the “County”) will hold a public hearing as required and authorized by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, with respect to a proposed plan of financing providing for the issuance of one or more series of multifamily housing revenue bonds or notes from time to time, including bonds or notes issued to refund such revenue bonds or notes from time to time (the “Bonds”), in the maximum principal amount \$50,000,000.

The proceeds of the Bonds, if issued, will be used to provide funds to make a loan to ECP Parcel A South Housing Partners, L.P., a California limited partnership (or an affiliate or assign thereof approved by the County) (the “Developer”), to finance the acquisition, development, construction or rehabilitation of a 70-unit multifamily residential rental housing development known as El Cerrito Plaza – Parcel A South located at 515 Richmond Street in the City of El Cerrito, California (the “Project”). The Project will be owned and operated by the Developer. All of the rental units in the housing development, except for one unit set aside for an on-site property manager, will be rented to persons and families of very low or low income.

The Bonds, if issued, will not constitute a debt or liability of the County, the State of California, or any other public body, or be in any way payable from taxes or other public funds.

Notice is further given that at said hearing, all proponents and opponents of the multifamily housing development and the financing thereof will have an opportunity to be heard on the question as to whether or not such Bonds should be issued. The hearing will commence at 9:00 a.m. Pacific Time (US and Canada) on April 4, 2025, or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard.

As a public health and safety precaution, no physical location will be available for the hearing. The hearing will be conducted by toll-free teleconference only.
